INTRODUCTION

- 1. Please take your Bibles and turn to 1 John chapter 2.
- 2. We are looking this morning at verses 20-29 as John continues his response to the many false teachers that have appeared and have deserted the fellowship of believers.
- 3. Read 1 John 2:18-29.

LESSON

John begins verse 20 with the Greek word kai which is translated "but".

This word is used in a variety of ways:

In Ephesians 4:11 it is used to connect the words pastors *and* teachers as one group rather than two.

It is also used to mark a contrast between two groups as in 1 John 2:20.

It could be translated "and" as in the ASV but every major translation translates it as "but."

Verses 18-19 identify the false teachers *but* verse 20 identifies the true believers.

Throughout verses 20-29 there are many contrasts given between false teachers and true believers:

I. The Contrast (vv.20-23)

- A. They Are Antichrists (v.18)
 - 1. Mentioned two times
 - 2. Antichrists are false teachers who lie and deceive (vv.22, 26)
 - 3. Verse 19 says "they were not really of us"
- B. You Are Christians (v.18)
 - 1. He calls them "children" 12 times
 - 2. "My little children" 1 time
 - 3. "Brethren" 3 times
- C. They Left (v.19)
 - 1. "They went out from us"

- 2. "They went out"
- D. You Remained (v.19)
 - 1. "For if they had been of us, they would have remained with us"
 - 2. Hebrews 10:36-39 (NASB) For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what was promised. ³⁷
 For yet in a very little while, He who is coming will come, and will not delay. ³⁸ But My righteous one shall live by faith; And if he shrinks back, My soul has no pleasure in him. ³⁹ But we are not of those who shrink back to destruction, but of those who have faith to the preserving of the soul.
- E. They Do Not Have the Holy Spirit
 - 1. This is implied in verse 20
 - 2. Jude 1:19 (NASB) These are the ones who cause divisions, worldly-minded, devoid of the Spirit.
- F. You Have the Holy Spirit (v.20) (unction)

- 1. What is the Anointing? (v.27)
 - a) Whatever it is it is from Jesus (the Holy One Mk.1:24)
 - b) It is someone you receive and lives in you
 - c) It is a person
 - d) The personal pronoun "Him" is used in verse27
- 2. It is the Holy Spirit (v.27)
- G. They are liars (v.22)
 - 1. They say they have not sinned (1:10)
 - 2. They do not keep God's commandments (2:4)
 - 3. They deny Jesus is the Christ (2:22)
 - 4. They hate believers (4:20)
 - 5. They do not believe God (5:10)
- H. You know the truth (vv.20-21)
 - 1. "And you all know" (v.20)
 - 2. Know what? The truth (v.21)
- I. They deny Jesus is the Christ (Messiah) (vv.22-23)

- J. You confess Jesus is the Christ (Messiah) (vv.23-24)
- K. They do not have eternal life (v.25)
 - 1. 1 John 3:15 (NASB) Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.
- L. You have eternal life (v.25)
 - 1. 1 John 5:11 (NASB) And the testimony is this, that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son.
 - 2. 1 John 5:13 (NASB) These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, so that you may know that you have eternal life.
 - 3. 1 John 5:20 (NASB) And we know that the Son of God has come, and has given us understanding so that we may know Him who is true; and we are in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God and eternal life.
