Now therefore fear the Lord, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the Lord. **15** And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. **16** And the people answered and said, God forbid that we should forsake the Lord, to serve other gods;

## John 4:5-9

Then cometh he to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that **Jacob** gave to his son Joseph. **6** Now **Jacob's well** was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with his journey, sat thus on the **well**: and it was about the sixth hour. **7** There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, Give me to drink. **8** (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.) **9** Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no **dealings** with the Samaritans.

**John 4:10-13**

**10** Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water. **11** The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the **well** is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water? **12** Art thou greater than our father **Jacob**, which gave us the **well**, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle? **13** Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:

## John 4:14-18

**14** But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a **well** of water springing up into everlasting **life**. **15** The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this water, that I thirst not, neither come hither to draw. **16** Jesus saith unto her, Go, call thy husband, and come hither. **17** The woman answered and said, I have no husband. Jesus said unto her, Thou hast **well** said, I have no husband: **18** For thou hast had five husbands; and he whom thou now hast is not thy husband: in that saidst thou truly.

## John 4:19-23

**19** The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet. **20** Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship. **21** Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. **22** Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. **23** But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
