## "Serving From The Soul!" 1 Thessalonians 2:8-12

#### Introduction:

- 1. Last Week, We Saw From 1 Thessalonians That Paul "Aimed To Please" That Is, His Primary Focus & Aim Was To Please The Lord!
  - For This Reason, He Preached The Gospel Of Christ!
    - He Didn't Conceal / Hide It!
    - He Didn't Change It!
    - He Didn't Compromise It!
    - Because, It Is The "Gospel Of God" (2:2)!
- 2. But, Paul Also Came To Help People! (Who Were Lost!)
  - In 1 Thessalonians 2:8-12, We Are Given A Glimpse Of Paul's Tender And Affectionate Heart The "Softer Side" Of Paul!
    - Beginning In 2:7, He Describes How He Came To The Thessalonians & How He Brought To Them The Gospel!
      - Read Text!
  - Paul Came Not To Demand From Them! (Like Support & Esteem)
    - He Came To Give To Them!
  - Paul Did Not Just Come Out Of A Sense Of Duty!
    - He Came Out With A Spirit Of Generosity!
  - The Spirit Through Which He Came Is Shown In 2:8!
    - "So being affectionately desirous of you, we were willing to have imparted unto you, not the gospel of God only, but also our own souls, because ye were dear unto us!"
    - He Came With All His Heart!
      - It Was His Desire / Delight ("Willing") / Devotion!
    - He Served With All His Soul!
      - He Came To "Impart" Some Gifts To Them!
      - The Gift Of The Savior! (Through The Gospel)
      - The Gift Of Himself His Soul!
- 3. Paul Gave Everything He Could In The Service Of This Church!
  - Not Like Jonah!
    - Like Paul, He Had A Message To Bring!
    - But He Did Not Bring It With All Of His Heart & Soul!
      - He Didn't Love The People! (Ninevites)
      - He Didn't Like The Results!
      - He Was "Displeased & Angry!" (Jonah 4:1)
  - No, When Paul Served, He Gave His "Own Soul!"
    - 2 Corinthians 12:15 "And I will very gladly spend and be spent for you!"
- 4. This Teaches Us How We Ought To Love & Serve Each Other!
  - Are We Serving With Our Souls?
    - As One Writer Put It: "Such A [Service] Is Costly!" (Hiebert)
      - Anything Of Value Has A Cost!
        - No Price To Pay ~ No Effect!
        - Materially! After Thanksgiving Sales! Christmas Presents! Cost Of Money!
        - Physically! After Thanksgiving Exercise! Cost Of Effort!
        - Spiritually! Cost Of Your Self Your Soul!
  - What Will It Take To Serve With Your Soul? There Will Be A Price!

## 1. The Cost Of Your Labor!

- IE: How Fulfilling It Is To Complete A Project, After A Lot Of Time & Toil Invested In The Work! Paul Felt The Same Way When He Worked To Share The Gospel!
- 2:9 "For ye remember, brethren, our labour and travail: for labouring night and day, because we would not be chargeable unto any of you, we preached unto you the gospel of God!"
- A Labor That Is Physical!

- "Labour And Travail!"
  - Paul Was A Tentmaker!
- Internal Fatigue / External Hardships!
- We Know What This Is Like In Our Careers!
- Do We Know What This Is Like In Our Church?
  - Real Service Requires: Exertion / Exhaustion!
- A Labor That Is Persistent!
  - "Night And Day!"
  - "Burnout" Was Not An Issue For Paul, Because His Heart & Soul Was Directed Toward The Right Place & The Right People!
  - We Know What "Workaholics" Are!
    - Would We Be Accused Of Being A "Servaholic"?
- A Labor That Is Purposeful!
  - Everything Paul Did Was To Help Him Share The "Gospel Of God" With Others!
    - Nothing Was Too Great A Cost For The Sake Of The Gospel!
    - Acts 20:24 "But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God!"
- Are You Serving With Your Soul?
  - If You Are, There Will Be A Cost! Of Your Labor!
    - What Are You Working For? Why?
    - What Are You Retired For? Why?
  - Is There A Purpose For Your Labor?
    - There Can Be!
  - Think About The "Labor And Travail" Of The Lord!
    - Mark 10:45 "For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many!"
- \* What Else Will It Take To Serve With Your Soul?
- 2. The Cost Of Your Living!
  - 2:10 "Ye are witnesses, and God also, how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that believe!"
    - Without This Kind Of Life, Your "Labor" For The Lord Will Be Ineffective & Powerless & Unfruitful!
      - IE: A Tree With No Strong Root Will Not Produce The Best Or The Most Fruit! Our Lives Are Like A Tree!
  - A Life Of Devotion! (The Root Of Our Life & Service)
    - "Holily!"
    - The Focus Of Your Heart & Life Is To Serve & Please The Lord!
      - God Is First In Your Heart / First In Your Motives / First In Your Conduct!
    - This Takes Time With The Lord!
  - A Life Of Duty! (The Trunk Of Our Life & Service Rings)
    - "Justly!"
    - The "Performance Of The Duties Of Life!" (Hiebert)
      - In The Right Manner!
      - With The Right Attitude!
    - This Takes Transparency Before Others!
  - A Life Of Decency! (The Leaves Of Our Life & Service Green)
    - "Unblameably!"
    - Free From Fault Or Defect!
      - Acts 24:16 "And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men!"
    - This Takes Toil!
  - This Kind Of Life Is What It Takes To Serve With Your Soul!
    - And This Kind Of Life Is What It Takes To See The Fruit From That Service!

- Are You Serving With Your Soul?
  - If You Are, There Will Be A Cost! Of Your Life!
  - Think About The Life Of The Lord!
- \* What Else Will It Take To Serve With Your Soul?
- 3. The Cost Of Your Language!
  - 2:11 "As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father doth his children!"
    - There Was Consistency In What Paul Said!
      - He "Practiced What He Preached!"
    - There Was Concern In What Paul Said!
      - "As A Father!"
        - Not Always Popular / But Always Important!
      - And So, He Spoke:
  - Words Of Challenge!
    - "Exhorted!"
    - To Come Along Side, And Aid Them In Their Walk With Christ! To Teach & Train About How To Respond To The Gospel & How To Live According To The Gospel!
      - Discipleship! "Every One Of You!"
  - Words Of Comfort!
    - "Comforted!"
    - To Encourage Them, Especially Through The Difficult Pressures They Were Experiencing & Would Experience!
  - Words Of Commitment!
    - "Charged!"
    - Paul Was A Witness To What He Received From The Lord!
      - He Was "Put In Trust With The Gospel!" (2:4)
    - So, He Declared The Truth To Them!
      - But, He Did So "In Love!" (Ephesians 4:15)
  - These Are The Words That We Must Bring!
    - This Is The Purpose Of Our Labor!
    - This Is The Purpose Of Our Living!
  - Are You Serving With Your Soul?
    - If You Are, There Will Be A Cost! Of Your Language!
    - Think About The Language Of The Lord!
      - Sometimes Words Of Challenge!
        - Sometimes Words Of Comfort!
        - All The Time Words Of Commitment!

### Conclusion:

- 1. Serving The Lord & Others With Your Soul Is Very Sacrificial & Costly!
  - It Will Cost You Much Labor! It Will Cost You Your Very Life! It Will Cost You In Your Language You Will Say Things That May Be Very Difficult & Even Dangerous!
    - But, It's The Most Worth-While Thing In The World To Do!
- 2. 2:12 "That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory!"
  - This Is Why Paul Served With All His Heart & Soul!
    - This Was His Aim & Purpose! Ours Also!
  - "That Ye Would Walk Worthy Of God!"
    - When God Uses Your Labor, Your Life & Your Language Your Selfless & Sacrificial Service From Your Very Soul God Uses This To Bring People Into This Kind Of Walk / Relationship With The Lord!
    - They Will Recognize His Sovereignty! "Kingdom!"
    - They Will Reflect His Splendor! "Glory!"
  - Doesn't This Make "Serving From The Soul" Worth It!
- 3. We Must Serve The Lord & Each Other With Our Souls!
