

## **Positive vs. Negative Energy**

What we know is that the New Age Movement believes that one day, due to “ignorance” and “an inability to evolve,” millions of people will be suddenly and instantly removed from the face of this planet. Satan has made preparation for this upcoming event by announcing it ahead of time, but simply putting a completely different twist on it.

If the event simply occurred, with absolutely no notice given to humanity, it is likely that at least some people would remember being taught about it from the Bible. They would panic, realizing that the Bible prophecy concerning the Rapture had actually occurred! They *were*, in point of fact, left behind.

This would not work for Satan’s plan at all. He would have to do something to draw attention away from the fact that this concept is taught in Scripture. He has a number of choices at his disposal, both of which he seems to have done:

1. **For Christians (professing and true):** Create doubt within them, so that they themselves do not believe the Rapture will occur. Have them focus on the rumor that Margaret MacDonald actually created the concept. If there are Christians who literally deny that the Rapture is going to occur, then this is what they will teach to everyone, those who believe it and those who do not believe it.
2. **For the Non-Christians (New Agers):** Get the word out way ahead of time that the Rapture *will* occur; however, the Bible has it wrong. The Great Evacuation will occur to remove Christians from the world, but as far as the world will understand it, these Christians are seen as trouble makers, keeping the planet and people from evolving to the next level.

Certainly, this is one reason why Satan began to disseminate his own version of the event of the Rapture. He *knows* without doubt that it *will* take place, unlike many Christians today, who deny a good deal of the as-yet-unfulfilled prophetic discourse. Some Christians, to be sure, are not in rebellion to God, nor do they desire to work against Him, but they are blind to His purposes related to the End Times. It is because of this that they *do* wind up inadvertently working against Him and His purposes. They do not envision a coming Rapture and many do not envision a coming Great Tribulation either, having sequestered the latter to the A.D. 70 event of Jerusalem’s destruction.

Satan, on the other hand, knows the Rapture will occur. He knows the Great Tribulation will occur and it is for this event that he is directing much of his energy and power. It is during this time that

Satan will reveal himself to the world through the Antichrist as a kind, intelligent, loving, tolerant man who because of these things will rise to rule the entire world through a global government of *Absolute Imperialism*.

Though Satan is working toward the final showdown that will occur at the end of the Great Tribulation, he does not know *when* either the Rapture or the Great Tribulation will actually occur. These times are in God's hands only, and only when that time arrives will the Rapture of the Church occur. After that, the beginning of the Great Tribulation (comprising a full seven years) will start, when the Antichrist is able to gain the trust of Israel, entering into a covenant with her for the seven years of the Tribulation/Great Tribulation.

Ever watchful, Satan continues to keep tabs on everything that happens in this world that he has no control over. This allows him to judge the times and seasons, but as we have seen, though that is not enough, it is the best he can do.

Even when things are clarified by Maitreya or some other entity as to why, for instance, the great planetary evacuation has not yet taken place, or why Maitreya himself has been unable to reveal himself, the blame is placed on those with *bad energy*. Because these things are happening as spoken of through these transmissions given over the space of twenty or thirty years, it is stated or implied that those who *keep things* from happening are the problem people of this world. So instead of doubting Maitreya's power and ability, eyes turn to the *problem* to see what can be done about that.

Within the New Age Movement, the concept of *energy* – both positive and negative – is *foundational*. Those with a negative energy (read: *Christians*) keep things *from* happening the way the New Age adherents have been told it is scheduled to happen.

Then, at the appointed time, they will literally *vacuum* the earth of that which keeps the planet and the people on it from entering a new phase of reality. Thus, the problem of earth's inability to rise to the next level of evolution will have been dealt with once and for all. Nothing then would continue to stand in the way of earth's advancement.

What is to be done with all these millions of people who are instantly whisked away from the planet? We look again to Chuck Missler, who quotes from the spring 1994 issue of *Connecting Link Magazine* from an article written by Kay Wheeler. Wheeler provides clarification on this upcoming event when millions in an instant will wind up missing. She states, "*Many of these beings who are leaving this planet at this time have completed that which they came to do. It is a time of great rejoicing for them. Do not feel sad about their*

*leaving. They are going home. Many are waiting to be with them again...Many beings must move on, for their thought patterns are of the past. They hold on to these thoughts that keep Earth held back.*"<sup>1</sup>Notice how Wheeler has *softened* the blow a bit here. While she states that these individuals are holding the Earth back from its natural evolutionary advancement, she states that these humans (referred to as "beings") are going to a better place, so while the world should experience a collective sigh of relief, it should also revel in the fact that these missing people are going to a better place.
