  - It is Christ living in and through you that they hate (Galatians 2:20)
    - As you grow in Christ-likeness, your persecution will grow

## 1 Peter 4:7-11

## IZ Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon.

When it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening: • Fiery Trial (ordeal) to test you-The purpose of the fiery trial is to test you (faith)

- Often we struggle to believe this because we can't see the good in our suffering (This is one aspect of the battle of faith)
- How does suffering/fiery trials test us? It tests our faith to prove if it is genuine or not.
- James 1:2 Count it all joy my brothers when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect & complete lacking in nothing.
- Luke 8:13 And the ones on the vock are those who, when they hear the word, veceive it with joy. But these have no voot; they believe for a while, and in time of testing fall away.
- I Peter 1:6 In this you rejoice, though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been grieved by various trials, so that the tested genuineness of your faith, more precious than gold that perishes though it is tested by fire-may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

## When, by God's grace, we stand the testing of our faith (in suffering/fiery trials), our faith is proved to be true.

Here Peter commands us to not only realize that we are being tested, but in light of that we must "rejoice"

## Insofar as you share Christ's sufferings: Suffering for Christ sake gives evidence that you are an heir with Him (Rom 8:17)

- Acts 5:40-41 And when they valled in the apostles, they beat them and charged them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name

- 2 Corinthians 4:17 For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison

As we strive to obey God and suffer persecution for doing good, we can sometimes look at the world and begin to wonder "Why am I suffering for doing good and they are seemingly being blessed for disobedience?"

- Peter deals with that thought here (Possibly a reference to Mal 3:1-5)
- The judgment regarding the "household of God" is a refining
- **1 Corinthians 11:32** But when we are judged by the Lord, we are disciplined so that we may not be condemned along with the world.
- God is purifying His church preparing her for the return of Christ

- We must realize we are sanctified in our suffering/persecution

#### Two important truths in this verse:

- "linw 2 bod of gain occording to God's will."
- It is never going to be more than we can bear (with His grace v14 Spirit, 1 Cor 10:13)
- It is always in love for our good (Romans 8:28, Hebrews 12:7-8, 2
   Corinthians 12:7-10)
- Even when sin is involved, God is sovereign over it (Acts 4:27)
- Knowing its God'perfect) will, we should "entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good"
- This is the battle (When the suffering seems too much, or we can't see the good in it, in faith entrusting our soul to God (the faithful Creator)
- Even to the point of death: Jesus demonstrated this perfectly Luke 23:46 Then Jesus, calling out with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commit my spirit!" And having said this he breathed his last.

#### Summary v12-18-In the midst of Christian suffering

- The Christian life is one of suffering (Do not be surprised)
- Suffering has a purpose (to test your faith)
- When our faith stands the test of time it builds assurance and
- Therefore rejoice in it
- Recognize the privilege of suffering for Christ
- Be glad about the future glory you will inherit
- God will grant His Spirit when needed (Call out for it)
- Make sure your suffering is not because of sin
- It is better to suffer for Christ than to be accepted by the world
- Our judgment is a purging and purifying suffering (sanctifying)
- The world's judgment is eternal damnation (Remember the
