I was only in Jerusalem for 12 days.

Not to riot, but to worship and to donate money.

Where are the Jews from Asia? My accusers?

It is all about the resurrection - now he turns to the gospel.

I have always lived in all good conscience before God and man.

Felix's Decision

The Case against Paul is weak, but politically complicated.

Felix - who was he?

His wives. His treachery.

Paul reasoned the gospel with them

Righteousness, self-control, and the coming judgment.

Go away, I will call for you at a convenient time.

The gospel is the thing not to be missed or neglected.
