Ps. 76:2-His tabernacle is in <u>Salem</u>; His dwelling place also is in <u>Zion</u>.

Josh. 15:63-Now as for the Jebusites, the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the sons of Judah could not drive them out; so the **Jebusites live with the sons of Judah at Jerusalem** until this day.

Ps. 110:4-The LORD has sworn and will not change His mind, "You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek."

Ps. 78:35-And they remembered that God was their rock, And the **Most High God** their Redeemer.

Josh. 5:13-15-¹³ Now it came about when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and behold, a man was standing opposite him with his sword drawn in his hand, and Joshua went to him and said to him, "Are you for us or for our adversaries?" ¹⁴ He said, "No; rather I indeed come now *as* captain of the host of the LORD." **And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and bowed down**, and said to him, "What has my lord to say to his servant?" ¹⁵ The captain of the LORD'S host

said to Joshua, "Remove your sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy." And Joshua did so.

Rev. 19:10-Then I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold the testimony of Jesus; worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

Rev. 22:8-9-8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who showed me these things. 9 But he said to me, "Do not do that.
