Heb. 11:4-By faith Abel offered to God a better sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained the testimony that he was righteous, God testifying about his gifts, and through faith, though he is dead, he still speaks.

Gen. 3:7-Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves waist coverings.

Gen. 21:8-10-8 And the child grew and was weaned, and Abraham held a great feast on the day that Isaac was weaned. 9 Now Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, whom she had borne to Abraham, mocking *Isaac*. 10 Therefore she said to Abraham, "Drive out this slave woman and her son, for the son of this slave woman shall not be an heir with my son Isaac!"

Gal. 4:28-31-<sup>28</sup> And you, brothers *and sisters*, like Isaac, are children of promise. <sup>29</sup> But as at that time the *son* who was born according to the flesh persecuted the one *who was born* according to the Spirit, so it is even now. <sup>30</sup> But what does the Scripture say? "DRIVE OUT THE SLAVE WOMAN AND HER SON, FOR THE SON OF THE SLAVE WOMAN SHALL NOT BE AN HEIR WITH THE SON OF THE FREE WOMAN." <sup>31</sup> So then, brothers *and* 

sisters, we are not children of a slave woman, but of the free woman.

John 16:2-They will ban you from the synagogue, yet an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering a service to God.

Jude 11-Woe to them! For they have gone <u>the way of Cain</u>, and for pay they have given themselves up to the error of Balaam, and perished in the rebellion of Korah.

Matt. 5:21-22-<sup>21</sup> "You have heard that the ancients were told, 'YOU SHALL NOT MURDER,' and 'Whoever commits murder shall be answerable to the court.' <sup>22</sup> But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother shall be answerable to the court; and whoever says to his brother, 'You good-fornothing,' shall be answerable to the supreme court; and whoever says, 'You fool,' shall be guilty *enough to go* into the fiery hell.

Eph. 4:26-BE ANGRY, AND YET DO NOT SIN; do not let the sun go down on your anger, <sup>27</sup> and do not give the devil an opportunity.

Josh. 1:8-This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it; for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will achieve success.
