It has been called "America's most disturbing holiday". Black Friday is the day when millions of average Americans wait outside retail stores in the middle of the night in the freezing cold to spend more money that they do not have for more cheap Chinese-made products that they do not need. It is a day when the rest of the world makes fun of Americans for behaving like "rabid animals" and "zombies" as we indulge in a tsunami of greed. It truly is a shameful orgy of materialism for a morally bankrupt nation.

The amount of merchandise that is purchased on Black Friday is absolutely staggering. For example, just consider how much stuff is sold at Wal-Mart alone...

Wal-Mart said it recorded more than 10 million register transactions between 6 p.m. and 10 p.m. Thursday in its stores and nearly 400 million page views that day on walmart.com. It sold 2.8 million towels, 2 million televisions, 1.4 million tablets, 300,000 bicycles and 1.9 million dolls. Big-ticket electronics like big-screen TVs and new videogame consoles were among the top sellers.

But each and every year, Black Friday also seems to bring out the worst in many people, and this year was certainly no exception. The following are just a few of the national headlines about the rioting and the violence that we witnessed...

And sometimes the violence extends out into the parking lots and into the surrounding neighborhoods. In <u>Las Vegas</u>, a man that was carrying a big-screen television home from Target was shot in the leg...

According to police, a man purchased a big-screen television from the Target store near Flamingo Rd. and Maryland Pkwy. While he was walking to a nearby apartment complex, a man approached and fired a warning shot, causing the victim to drop the television, police said.

Officers tell 8 News NOW the gunman then took the television to a nearby car that was waiting, where a second man helped the gunman load the TV into the car.

The victim approached the two men and tried to get the television back. That prompted the gunman to fire several more rounds, shooting the victim in the leg.

These are the Requirements of Spiritual Unity

1. Being of same Mind Gk Phroneo Think alike

I Cor. 1:10

Unity comes when we think alike

Not just doctrine
This is beyond doctrine
This is Attitude

Same feeling, disposition, attitude or concern.

This is not possible on a fleshly human level, only will happen on a spiritual level

This is the basis behind believer marring believers, Believer and unbelievers have a different attitude or mind set

The term phroneo is used here to help us understand Romans 8:4---

We must have spiritual thoughts

Conflict is always spirit vs flesh or flesh vs flesh but Never spirit vs spirit

Romans 12:3----

We must have sound objective Biblical God centered judement Not subjective, our own feeling and desires

Romans 15:5

We must have Christ Centered thoughts

Conflict is always the collision of sinful attitudes

In Romans 12:10 it puts it this way, "Be devoted to one another in brotherly love." Be devoted to one another means to meet one another's needs, "Greater love hath no man than this that a man lay down his life for his friends." First John 3 says that if you look on your friend and he has needs and you close up your compassion to him, it's questionable whether the love of God even dwells in you. Love acts in behalf of someone else's need. God so loved the world that He gave what man so desperately needed. This is an element of unity. Loving everyone the same.

Now let me make it as clear as I can. When you think the things of the Spirit, when you have the sound spiritual objective judgment of God, when you think with the mind of Christ, when you think with maturity, and when you think spiritually, and when you think heavenly, you will maintain the same love. Because Christ and the Spirit will be loving through you and love for one another will be the outflow.
