## **Teaching our Children**

I was not sure that young children need to have the concepts of these verses taught to them on an individual and more personal level. Perhaps they are not yet ready to face the reality of spiritual wolves in sheep's clothing?

At this point, I think the best way for us to "teach" our children this text (or prepare them to apply it in the future) is to make sure that we ourselves are faithfully bearing the good fruit of holiness and sound doctrine as our children's teachers in the home.

Let us continue to immerse them in the "genuine article", and when the time is right, warn them about the counterfeits.
