## II. **Matthew 1:17-23**

**A.** <sup>18</sup> Now the birth of **Jesus** Christ was as follows: After His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, **before they came together**, she was found with child of the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly.

**B.** <sup>20</sup> But while he **thought about these things**, behold, an **angel of the Lord** appeared to him in a **dream**, saying, "**Joseph**, son of David, do not be afraid to **take to you Mary your wife**,

**C.** for that which is **conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.** <sup>21</sup> And she will **bring forth a Son**, and you shall call **His name JESUS**, for He will save His people from their sins."

**D.** <sup>22</sup> So all this was done that it might be **fulfilled** which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying:

**C'.** <sup>23</sup> "Behold, the **virgin** shall be with child, and **bear a Son**, and they shall call **His name Immanuel**," which is translated, "God with us."

**B'.** <sup>24</sup> Then **Joseph**, being **aroused from sleep**, did as the **angel of the Lord** commanded him and **took to him his wife**,

**A'.** <sup>25</sup> and **did not know her** till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His name **JESUS**.
