Stewardship In Light Of Eternity

Matthew 6:19-24 Pastor Phil Winfield January 13, 2013

Here are a few summary statements from last time.

- We are supposed to use money and treasure people; we are not supposed to use people and treasure money.
- Steward Someone an owner **entrust** with the management of **his assets**.
- Primary Goal of a steward **to be found faithful** in managing the owner's assets. *1 Corinthians 4:2 Moreover it is required in stewards that one be found faithful.*
- Since God owns everything: Every financial decision is a **spiritual decision**.
- Stewardship is not a sub-category of the Christian life: It is the Christian Life.
- The owner (of all) will return and he will **demand an accounting** of all. Rom 14:12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.

Still not sure about whether God is interested in your finances? Luke 3:7-14 John's major evidence of repentance was a change of attitude **toward finances**.

Jesus speaks about managing money in light of eternity

- 1. Choose your **kingdom** carefully
 - a. Choose between earth or heaven as your <u>treasury</u> (verses 19-21) No earthly treasure is <u>safe</u>
 - **b.** Choose between a good eye or an evil eye (verses 22-23) Covetousness is **idolatry**
 - i. Col 3:5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness (greed) which is idolatry.
 - c. Choose between God or money as your <u>master</u> (verse 24) You only have one <u>throne</u> in your life
- 2. Consider your **eternal** destiny (verse 20) ...in heaven!
 - a. You can't take it with you but you can **send it** on ahead!
 - b. You can't reinterpret scripture to your own liking the subject is **generosity**!
 - i. Luke 12:33-34 Sell what you have and give alms; provide yourselves money bags which do not grow old, a treasure in the heavens that does not fail, where no thief approaches nor moth destroys. 34 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
 - ii. 1 Tim 6:18-19 Let them do good (the wealthy), that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, 19 storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.
 - c. You can't show proof of a desire for Heaven if you have little invested there.
 - i. Ps 16:11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

- 3. Count on a **reward** in eternity (verse 20) "lay up for yourselves..."
 - a. Heavenly rewards are **God's idea** *Matt 16:27 For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.* (See also Matt 6:1-2; 1 Cor 3:8; Col 3:24; 2 John 8; Rev 22:12)
 - b. Heavenly Rewards <u>cannot be lost</u> Lk 12:33-34 (Above)
 - c. Heavenly rewards <u>reveal</u> your heart *Mt 6:21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*

Final thoughts:

- Be an Obedient Owner out of <u>love for God</u> Deut 7:9 "Therefore know that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him and keep His commandments;
- Be an obedient Owner out of reverent <u>fear of God</u> Heb 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.
- Be an Obedient Owner believing God's promise of a reward Heb 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.
