Leader: Which is the eighth commandment?
People: The eighth commandment is, Thou shalt not steal.
Leader: What is required in the eighth commandment?
People: The eighth commandment requires the lawful procuring and furthering the wealth and outward estate of ourselves and others.
Leader: What is forbidden in the eighth commandment?
People: The eighth commandment forbids whatsoever does, or may, unjustly hinder our own, or our neighbor’s wealth or outward estate. (Shorter Catechism 73-75)

People: Hide your face from our sins, O God, and blot out all our iniquities.
All: Cast us not away from your presence. Do not take your Holy Spirit from us. Restore to us the joy of your salvation.
