The Greek word for fellowship is koinonia. It is translated several ways in the NT: for example, “participation,” “partnership,” “sharing,” and, of course, “fellowship.” These various uses of koinonia convey two relate meanings: (1) to share together in the sense of joint participation or partnership, and (2) to share with in the sense of giving what we have to others. Fellowship is sharing a common life with other believers, a life that we together share with God the Father and God the Son. It is a relationship, not an activity.
