"The Heart Of The Gospel" Philemon 8-14

Introduction:

- 1. What Would You Do?
 - What Would You Do If *You*:
 - Had Serious Health Problems Including:
 - Diabetes & Heart Disease:
 - And In The Last Few Years You Suffered:
 - Three Heart Attacks The Last Of Which Led To Congestive Heart Failure With Only 1/3 Of Your Heart Functioning:
 - And You Are Near Death!

- What Would You Do:
 - If After Being Told That There Is Nothing:
 - That Can Be Done To Help You:
 - Someone Suggests A Surgery:
 - That Has Never Even Been Attempted Before? It's Experimental! And You're The Guinea Pig!
 - A Complete Heart Transplant!

- What Would You Do?
 - Well A Man By The Name Of:
 - Louis Washkansky Faced All Of This:
 - Back In 1967! And What Did He Do?
 - He And His Wife Agreed To The Surgery!
- And On December 3, 1967 In Cape Town, South Africa:
 - After A 6 Hour Surgery Involving:
 - A Team Of 30 Surgeons, Nurses & Technicians:
 - The First Ever Human Heart Transplant:
 - Was A Success!
- Or At Least For:
 - Another 18 Days When His Body Succumbed:
 - To Complications From Pneumonia & A Weakened Immune System!
- 2. But Since That First Successful Attempt:
 - Heart Transplant Surgery:
 - Has Become More & More Common & Effective!
 - Today Around 3,500 Transplants Are Performed:
 - Every Year Throughout The World!
 - But For Each Transplant Patient:
 - There Is A Story & A History:
 - Of A Weak *Physical* Heart!
 - And The Only Hope They Have:
 - Is A Newer & A Stronger One!
- 3. Well Even Though The Number Of Candidates:
 - For Heart Transplant Surgery Is A Pretty Small Number:
 - And Hopefully A Decision You Will Never Have To Face!
 - Yet There Is An Even Greater Disease:
 - That Infects The *Spiritual* Hearts:
 - Of Every Man & Woman & Child!
 - The Disease Of Sin!

- And This Disease:
 - Does Not Just Make Your Heart Weak:
 - It Has Already Caused Your Heart:
 - To Die!
 - And This Means *Every* Person Is A Candidate:
 - For A *Different* Kind Of Heart Transplant!
 - A *Spiritual* Transplant!
- 4. Well Praise God This Is Exactly:
 - Why God The Father Sent His Son Jesus Into This World!

- To Provide The Kind Of Heart Transplant:
 - That You And I Needed:
 - For Spiritual & For Eternal Life!
- In Ezekiel 36:36 The Lord Said:
 - "A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh!"
 - That's A Heart Transplant!
 - And It's the Only Solution For A Spiritually Dead Heart!
- Have You Received:
 - Your New Heart Yet?
 - God Himself, The Greatest Of Physicians, Performs This Transplant Surgery:
 - When You Turn From Your Sin & Trust In The Lord Jesus Christ As Your Savior!
 - And Not Only Does Your Heart Change, So Does Your Whole Life!
 - And Not Just For 18 Days! But For Eternity!
- 5. As We Head Back To Paul's Brief Letter To Philemon:
 - This Morning I Think That We Can See & Hear:
 - What The Throbbing Of This New & Healthy Heart:
 - From God Is Like!
 - As The Apostle Paul Uses *His* New Heart To Appeal To *Philemon's* New Heart:
 To Receive Back His Runaway Slave, Onesimus, Who Has *Also* Received A New Heart!
 - And We See This In:
 - 1:8-14 "Wherefore, though I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin thee that which is convenient, / 9 Yet for love's sake I rather beseech thee, being such an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ. / 10 I beseech thee for my son Onesimus, whom I have begotten in my bonds: / 11 Which in time past was to thee unprofitable, but now profitable to thee and to me: / 12 Whom I have sent again: thou therefore receive him, that is, mine own bowels: / 13 Whom I would have retained with me, that in thy stead he might have ministered unto me in the bonds of the gospel: / 14 But without thy mind would I do nothing; that thy benefit should not be as it were of necessity, but willingly!"
- 6. Now We Have Already Seen:
 - That The Issue Paul Is Dealing With Is:
 - A Very Sensitive Issue! And So He Handles It:
 - With Much Grace & Tact!
 - But Through It All I Believe We Can See The New & Strong Heart That Christians Receive From Christ!
 - Because In Christ There Is:
- 1. A New Kind Of Appeal!
 - An Appeal To The Heart!
 - This Is What We Find In 1:9 When Paul:
 - Makes His Appeal To Philemon:
 - "For Love's Sake!"
 - You See As An Apostle Of Jesus Christ:
 - Who Was Given Great Authority:
 - In The Development Of The Church:
 - He Could Have Appealed:
 - To The Authority Of Christ!
 - Which He Briefly Mentions In:
 - 1:8 "Wherefore, though I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin [Command] thee that which is convenient [Fit & Proper]!"
 - You See Paul Was Given Spiritual

Authority Over The Church & Even Over Philemon! And - He Could Very Well Have Ordered Philemon To Do What He Wanted Him To Do!

- However Paul Wanted Even As Christ Wants:
 - Obedience To His Will To Go Deeper!
 - To Come From The Heart!
 - So That What The Lord Said To Jeremiah Will Come True Jeremiah 31:33 -
 - "After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and

write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people!"

- Paul Could Have Made His Appeal To Philemon:
 - Based On His Authority!
 - But Even Though He Briefly Reminds Him Of His Authority:
 - He Makes His Appeal Instead:
- To The Allegiance Of Christ!
 - Which He Describes Again In:
 - 1:9 "Yet for love's sake I rather beseech thee, being such an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ!"
 - Paul Appeals To The Heart:
 - And To Christian Love!
 - A Love From Christ!
 - A Love For Christ!
 - A Love In Christ!
 - And A Love Like Christ's!
 - And With This Paul Makes:
 - A Request Not A Requirement!
 - A Plea And Not A Prescription!
 - It's His Desire Not A Decree!
 - "I Beseech The!"
 - Because A Response From The Heart:
 - Is What Matters Most:
 - To The Lord!
- And To Tug On Philemon's Heart Strings A Bit More:
 - He Reminds Him Of His Own:
 - Humanity! "As Paul The Aged!"
 - Now By This Time Paul Was Probably Around 60 Years Old Perhaps Not That Old By Age, But Old By Aging Since He Bore In His Body "The Marks Of The Lord Jesus!" Like The Aging Of A President In Office! Grey!
 - He Reminds Him Of His Own:
 - Humility! "A Prisoner Of Jesus Christ!"
- Now What Is Paul's Primary Motive Here?
 - Is He Just Trying To Manipulate Philemon?
 - I Believe That By Reminding Philemon Of His Own Plight:
 - He Wants Philemon To Listen To His Words Even More Intently!
 - Because If Philemon Loved & Cared For Paul:
 - Then What Paul Loved & Cared For:
 - Would Be Important To Philemon As Well!
 - **IE:** Kind Of Like Being Asked To Conduct A Funeral For A Loved One Of A Loved One! I Don't Know Them! But I Will Care For The One As I Care For The Other! This Is All Paul Wanted!
 - He Appealed To His Heart!
 - And Isn't This The Way That God Appeals To You:
 - If You Are His Child & If He's Given You A New Heart!
 - Even Though God Remains:
 - The Sovereign & Supreme Authority:
 - Over You & Over Me & Over Everyone & Over Everything!
 - Yet He Now Appeals To Your Heart! A Heart Of Love & Allegiance Toward Him!
 - Isn't This What We Find In The Rest Of Paul's Letters?
 - In Romans 12:1 He Appeals To Your Heart:
 - "I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service!"
 - In 1 Corinthians 10:1 He Appeals To Your Heart:
 - "Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ, who in presence am base among you, but being absent am bold toward you!"
 - Though God Deserves Your Submission To His Authority:
 - He Delights In Your Heart Of Allegiance:

- To Him - Out Of Love!

- In Christ - There Is A New Kind Of Appeal!

- An Appeal - To The Heart!

- But Also - In Christ - There Is:

2. A New Kind Of Affection!

- An Affection From The Heart!
 - This Is What We Find In 1:12 When Paul Describes Onesimus As:
 - "Mine Own Bowels!"
 - Which Is The Term They Used For:
 - The Seat Of Their Emotions:
 - That Is Their Heart!
 - In 1:10-12 Paul Is Serving:
 - As An Advocate For Onesimus:
 - That Fugitive, Runaway Slave!
 - But Listen To Paul's Loving Description Of This Man!
 - He Describes:
- The Conversion Of Onesimus!
 - In 1:10 "I beseech thee for my son Onesimus, whom I have begotten in my bonds!"
 - This Shows The Personal Affection & Lasting Concern That Paul Had For Onesimus!
 - Now We Don't Know All Of The Circumstances:
 - But Somehow God Led Onesimus To Paul:
 - So That Paul Could Lead Onesimus To Christ!
 - Like Timothy & Like Titus Before Him:
 - Onesimus That Fugitive Slave:
 - Became One Of Paul's Own "Sons In The Faith!"
 - So He Was In Good Company!
 - But What Memories & Feeling:
 - This Must Have Brought To Paul's Mind & Heart!
 - Now At This Point Philemon Would Probably Have Been Pleased With This News! That His Slave Had Been Converted To Christ! But What Does This Have To Do With Him? Surely, With His Slave Back, Things Could Get Back To Normal!
 - But "Back To Normal" Was Not What Paul Was After!
 - He Then Describes:
- The Change Of Onesimus!
 - In 1:11 "Which in time past was to thee unprofitable, but now profitable to thee and to me!"
 - To Appreciate This Verse You Need To Remember That The Name "Onesimus" Means "Useful!"
 - It Was A Common Name For A Slave Back Then And Philemon May Have Even Been The One To Give Him That Name! When He Was Born Or When He Was Bought!
 - And He Hoped That His Slave Would Live Up To His Name!
 - But It Is Clear That Onesimus Was *Not*:
 - Useful! As Paul Puts It Here:
 - "In Time Past Was To Thee Unprofitable!"
 - It Seems That Onesimus Was A Genuine Scoundrel!
 - He Possessed A Poor Character:
 - All Around! Not Just In How He Served:
 - But In His Attitudes & Actions!
 - He Was "Good For Nothing!"
 - But Now There's Been A Change Paul Writes!
 - "Now" He's "Profitable To Thee And To Me!"
 - Reminds Us Of 2 Corinthians 5:17 "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new!"
 - And Paul's Heart Was Greatly Moved For Onesimus:
 - Because Of The Great Change:
 - The Lord Had Done In That Slave's Heart & Life!
 - And This Is Where Paul Further Describes:
- The Connection Of Onesimus!

- 1:12 "Whom I have sent again: thou therefore receive him, that is, mine own bowels!"
 - A Special Relationship & Connection:
 - Quickly Blossomed Between Paul & Onesimus:
 - As A Spiritual Father With A Spiritual Son!
- And Paul Loved Onesimus!
 - His Heart Was Bound Up With His!
 - And So He Asks Philemon To Treat His Slave As He Would Treat Paul's Own Heart!
 - "Receive Him!" And Please Don't Break My Heart!
- Oh What Affection Paul Had For Onesimus!
 - An Affection That Can Only Come:
 - Through Christ!
 - But Doesn't Paul's Heart Of Affection Reflect The Heart & Affection:
 - Of Christ Himself Toward His Own Children?
 - When You Become A Christian:
 - There Is Now:
 - A Special Connection:
 - Between You And Your Savior!
 - And Now "He That Toucheth You Toucheth The Apple Of His Eye!" (Zechariah 2:8)
 - And Because Of Christ's Love For You:
 - You Can Love Him & Love Others:
 - They Way He Wants You To!
 - From The Heart!
 - But Also In Christ There Is:
- 3. A New Kind Of Aspiration!
 - An Aspiration By The Heart!
 - Which Is What We See In 1:14 When Paul Desires Philemon To Do What He Asks:
 - "Willingly!"
 - Once Again Paul Humbly Defers To Philemon Because *He* Wants What *God* Wants! His Heart! And:
 - A Willing Service!
 - In 1:13 Paul Wrote "Whom I would have retained with me, that in thy stead he might have ministered unto me in the bonds of the gospel!"
 - Paul Makes The Assumption:
 - That Philemon Would Like To Serve Paul There In Rome!
 - He Also Assumes:
 - That If He Had Kept Onesimus Philemon Would Have Been OK With That!
 - This Shows The Kind Of Esteem:
 - That Paul Had For Philemon, As His Brother In Christ!
 - But To Just Assume These Things Or To Require These Things:
 - Was Not Wise & Was Not Best!
 - Because It May Not Have Been Done From The Heart!
 - Instead Paul Desired & The Lord Desires:
 - A Willing Surrender!
 - Which Paul Explains In:
 - 1:14 "But without thy mind would I do nothing; that thy benefit should not be as it were of necessity, but willingly!"
 - This Is The Kind Of Heart:
 - God Wants From His People!
 - Reminds Us Of:
 - What Paul Writes About Giving In The Church:
 - In 2 Corinthians 9:7 Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver!"
 - Paul Understood That:
 - True Forgiveness:
 - Which Is What He Desired For Onesimus:

- Must Come From The Heart!
- And That True Fellowship:
 - Which Is What He Desired For Himself:
 - Must Also Come From The Heart!
- And Only In Christ Is There This Kind Of New Aspiration!
 - An Aspiration By The Heart!
 - To Serve & To Surrender Yourself:
 - To The Lord:
 - Willingly!

Conclusion:

- 1. Does The Lord Have Your Heart This Morning?
 - If You Have Been Given That:
 - "Spiritual Heart Transplant" Through Faith In The Gospel:
 - Then No Longer Does The Lord:
 - Just Appeal To You:
 - As A Servant, But As A Son & A Daughter Of The King!
 - He Gave You A New Heart:
 - So That You Can Love Him & Obey Him & Serve Him:
 - From That Heart!
- 2. And With That Heart:
 - You Can Now Love Others:
 - As Christ Loves You!
 - This Is Why Paul Wrote This Letter:
 - On Behalf Of Onesimus:
 - In The First Place!
 - Because He Loved Him With All His Heart!
 - Is There An Onesmius In Your Life Today?
 - Is There Someone Who You Can Shower:
 - The Love Of Christ Upon?
 - Not Because Of What They Can Do For Or Give To You!
 - But Because Of What You Can Do For & Give To Them!
 - Perhaps You Need To Find:
 - Your Own Onesmius!
 - A Brother Or Sister That You Can Love & Encourage & Disciple:
 - For Their Good & For God's Own Glory!
- 3. This Is The New Kind Of Heart:
 - That You Have Been Given:
 - If You Are A Christian!
 - So Let Your Heart Be Tender:
 - To The Lord!
 - Say As We Will Soon Sing:
 - "I Am Thine, Lord, Here's My Heart!"

- Because This Is:
 - The Heart Of The Gospel!
