Why should we worship the LORD?
In our English translations approximately times in the Psalms we see the word 'Yehovah' translated 'LORD' in capital letters.
YEHOVAH/YAHWEH is the proper name of the one true God and means God is the self-existent One.

Worship expresses an attitude ofreverence and adoration.

The word <u>must</u> in verse 24 is translated from the Greek verb dei (pronounced day) and denotes something that isnecessary.
Where and when do we worship the LORD?
The worship Jesus spoke of takes place in the mind,and the spirit and can happenand at any time.
"What does it mean to worship in spirit and truth?
Some translations capitalize the "s" in spirit in vs.24. When the "s" is capitalized by the translators it is an indication in their thinking that the Greek noun pneuma is referring to the Holy Spirit.
E.g., The N.I.V. says, "God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."
The N.I.V., reads "God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth."
But the majority of the translations such as the K.J.V., N.K.J.V., N.A.S., E.S.V. and many others don't capitalize the "s" in spirit.
