1. Since our body belongs to the Holy Spirit, we cannot glorify Him if we participate in those things that dominate us (1 Corinthians 6:12-20; Proverbs 5:20; Ephesians 5:18)
2. The godly man should never stand in the way of sinners or sit in the seat of scoffers (Psalm 1:1)

6. It is evil to enjoy the immodesty that results from Satan's cultural deceptions (1 Corinthians 13:6; Philippians 4:8)
7. It is evil to seek pleasure by learning about sexual sins - even if we don't actually watch them and say we'd never do them ourselves (Ephesians 5:11-12)
8. It is evil to enjoy abuse
9. It is evil to support slavery

10.It is evil to believe the lie of "consent"

11.It is evil to fund evil

12.The sexual rebellion of others should never be the Christian's entertainment

13.It is evil to enjoy someone else's use of their sexual appeal to earn money or attention

14.It is evil to enjoy someone else's public display of their nakedness (Ezekiel 23; Proverbs 5:15-19)

15.It is evil to enjoy someone else's public display of a sexual relationship (Hebrews 13:4; Proverbs 5:15-19)

16.Hook-up culture and pre-marital sex should not be the Christian's entertainment

17.Wishing to have access to someone else's nakedness is sinful covetousness (Matthew 5:28; Proverbs 6:25)

18.Imagining what it would be like to have a sexual relationship with someone else is sinful covetousness (Matthew 5:28)

19.It is evil to enjoy the results of Satan's crusade against life (John 10:10)
