- 1. What was the problem plaguing the church in Colossae?

- 3. What does "firstborn of all creation" mean and what does it not mean (v. 15)?
- 4. Who is presented as the Creator (v. 16)?
- 5. What is the ultimate source for why everything in the world coheres and holds together rather than disintegrating (v. 17)?
- 6. In 1:18-20 Paul emphasizes that Christ is supreme over what?
- 7. Who is the Head of the Church (v. 18a) and what does this mean?
- 8. What does the word "beginning" (v. 18b) imply?
- 9. In 1:21-23 over what is Christ supreme?
- 10. In 2:9-15 in what four major areas is Christ's work of supremacy highlighted?

Questions to Discuss and Consider at Home or in Small Group:

- 1. Give a brief summary of Solus Christus.
- 2. Why was *Solus Christus* so important in the 16th century setting?
- 3. What is the distinction between necessary and sufficient? Why was (and still is) this important in the issues raised in the 16th century?
- 4. How well do you think the Church understands and practices *Solus Christus* today?
- 5. What are some ways you see the Church undermining *Solus Christus*?
- 6. What is "eudaimonism"? How is this exhibited by people in the Church?
- 7. What is a popular, common view of preaching in many church settings today? How should *Solus Christus* impact preaching and teaching? How should it impact worship? Discipleship? Marriage? Parenting? Education?
