A. The question that the text answers is this: how can we know God is for us?

B. God spared not His own Son.

C. He delivered him up

**II. The Recipients - for us all**

A. The for us all does not refer to all people head-for-head, but only the elect.

B. The word all is important here also.

**III. The Blessing**

A. How shall he not not with him also freely give us all things?

B. The idea here is that Paul argues from the greater to the lesser to expose and reveal the heart of God toward us all.
