

Fresh Oil

Psalm 92:10

But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil.

I. Anointing with oil

A. It symbolized being set apart unto the Lord.

1. The High Priest of Israel
 - Exodus 30:30
2. Men who served as kings of Israel
 - a. Saul
 - I Samuel 10:1
 - b. David
 - I Samuel 16:12-13

B. It was symbolic of the abundance of God's blessings.

- Psalm 23:5

C. It was symbolic of the Holy Spirit.

- I Samuel 10:6
- I Samuel 16:13

II. An anointing with fresh oil

- Psalm 92:10

I shall be anointed with fresh oil

A. David had experienced God's blessing and power.

1. David had experienced God's kindness and faithfulness. (v. 2)
 2. David had known God's mighty works. (v. 4)
 3. David had battled with God's enemies. (v. 9)

B. David was talking about “fresh” oil.

- (v. 10) *I shall be anointed with fresh oil.*

III. How to have or receive fresh oil.

A. Understand the Holy Spirit’s presence

1. In the Old Testament, His presence was temporary.
 - John 14:16-17
 - Psalm 51:11
2. After Pentecost, His presence is permanent.
 - I Corinthians 6:19

B. Recognize we have God’s power

- Luke 24:49
- Acts 1:8

C. Desire the Holy Spirit’s control

- Ephesians 5:18

With the Holy Spirit’s filling comes God’s blessings and the experiencing of His power.

This is accomplished by:

1. Pursuing pure lives (confessing and forsaking all known sin)
 2. Yielding to the Spirit’s control (surrendering to God's will, obeying His Word)
 - ❖ Being filled with the Spirit is living in the conscious presence of the Lord Jesus Christ, letting His mind, through the Word, dominate everything that is thought and done.
