- B. And those who commit adultery with her
- C. Unless they repent of her deeds

 - 1. This will be a testimony to the others. How we are supposed to learn the lessons.

V. Commendation and Exhortation (24-25)

- A. But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira,
 - 1. Who do not hold this teaching
 - 2. Who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them
- B. I place no other burden on you
- C. Nevertheless, what you have, hold fast until I come

VI. Promise to overcomers and call to hear (26-29)

"What is surprising is that victorious Christians are promised a share in the Messiah's own task." Boxall

- A. The one overcoming and keeping my works until the end
- B. I shall give to him authority over the nations Psa 2:8-9
- C. I will give him the morning star Morning star (Cf. Num. 24:17; Rev. 22:16) – Messianic victory and rule
- D. The call to hear
