 The words of the prophets oracles of judgment (curses) and oracles of salvation (blessings)
 - 1. He bears the curse and judgment of the broken covenant (Isa. 53, suffering Servant)
 - 2. He fulfills the covenant demands through His obedience (not only the suffering Servant, He is the obedient Servant. Isa. 50:5/Righteous Branch/The LORD our Righteousness, Jer. 23)
 - 3. He inaugurates the New Covenant in His blood, the Kingdom (primary object of the Prophets' message of promise and hope)
 - C. Christ fulfills the office of Prophet (consummately)
