Q. 24 How does Christ execute the office of a priest?

A. Christ executes the office of a priest, in his once offering up himself a sacrifice to satisfy divine justice (Heb 9:28), and to reconcile us to God (Heb 2:17), and in making continual intercession for us (Heb 7:25).

- 1. Offered Himself to satisfy divine justice.
- 2. Reconciled us to God.
- 3. Makes continual intercession for us.

Q. 25 How does Christ execute the office of a king?

A. Christ executes the office of a king in subduing us to himself, (Ps. 110:3) in ruling and defending us (Mat 2:6; 1Cor 15:25), and in restraining and conquering all his and our enemies.
