3. ALIGN THE DEFINITION (WHAT) WITH THE DESCRIPTION (HOW)
 - a. NINTH COMMANDMENT - WSC 76-78 - SEE EPHESIANS 4:15
 - (1) SPEAK THE TRUTH WITH KINDNESS AND PATIENCE
 - (2) DO NOT SPEAK THE TRUTH W/ ENIVOUS EDGE, COVETING SELF-IMPORTANCE OR RECOGNITION
 - (3) DO NOT PUFF UP YOURSELF WITH THE TRUTH
 - (4) DO NOT PEPPER TRUTH WITH VULGARITIES OR RUDENESS
 - (5) DO NOT DENIGRATE OTHERS USING YOURSELF AS A STANDARD
 - (6) DO NOT PROVOKE OTHERS BY THE TRUTH
 - (7) DO NOT LIST THE SINS OF OTHERS ALTHOUGH TRUE
 - (8) REJOICE IN THE TRUTH
 - b. SIXTH COMMANDMENT - WSC 67-69 - MATTHEW 5:21-22
 - c. SEVENTH COMMANDMENT - WSC 70-72 - MATTHEW 5:27-28
