THE BOOK OF ACTS

The crucified, risen, and ascended King is working for the progress of the gospel thru simple preaching of prayerful disciples to whom God's Spirit is giving power.

This progress can't be stopped, not even by <u>persecution</u> on the outside or by <u>problems</u> on the inside.

WHAT'S LUKE'S (& GOD'S) MAIN POINT?

Paul is speaking to a king.

Luke 21:12, "They will lay their hands on you and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues and prisons, and you will be brought before kings and governors for my name's sake."

Acts 9:15, "The Lord Jesus said to [Ananias], 'Go, for [Paul] is a chosen instrument of mine to carry my name before the Gentiles and kings and the children of Israel."

WHAT'S LUKE'S (& GOD'S) MAIN POINT?

The gospel can be reasonably explained and defended among the upper crust of society.

HOW THE GOSPEL CONFRONTS HIGH SOCIETY

- 1. The gospel confronts governmental leaders (even wicked ones) respectfully.
- 2. Gospel messengers must not be impressed with pomp.
- 3. The gospel message itself doesn't change a bit when spoken to "important" people.
- 4. The gospel is usually rejected by "significant" people.
