INTRODUCTION

- 1. Sons of Most High: Administer God's gov't among men imitate Father <u>v35-36</u> matters of conscience: *judgment* <u>v37</u> judge in courtroom
- **2.** The necessity of moral judgment. Creation is *good* [Gn 1:31]; man images God who is Judge. Everything is morally assessed: conscience.
- **3**. 1st: know self as *son of Most High* [salvation], then differentiate *disciples* [v20] & *enemies* [v27] = "judge". Then treat as Father judges us in Jesus.
 - i. Gospel love: among disciples -> church: forebear & forgive: worship
 - ii. Gospel love among enemies: witness in view 2nd coming: FJ. Compassion w/ sober realism of Satan, sin, death, hatred.

1st: The Context of Pharisaical Judgmentalism

- 1. Prohibited from faultfinding while ignoring one's own sins: cruel, critical.
 - i. <u>Lk 5:21</u> displays of divine compassion & love Phars are cynical
 - ii. $\underline{v30}$ J eating w/ sinners, but Phars hypercritical;
 - iii. <u>v33</u> judging kata their traditions re: fasting;
 - iv. <u>6:2</u> probing in order to find fault;
 - v. <u>6:7</u> HS here informs of motives intent on finding fault iva accuse;
 - vi. <u>6:11</u> Phars misjudge we are to judge as we are judged by Father
 - vii. We are to judge but not like Pharisees Mt 23:23
- 2. Hyperbole underscores importance: do not judge as sinners judge.

2nd: Disciples of Jesus Are Not to Judge

- 1. *judge* = court: differ good from bad; guilt/innocence; reward/punish
- 2. Here *judge* is a synonym *condemn* so as to *pardon*.
- 3. We must make moral assessments.
 - i. <u>Mt 7:6</u> dogs & swine = obstinate opposition: context $\underline{v1-2}$
 - ii. <u>Jn 7:24</u> Jesus is being misjudged as Sabbath-breaker is He?
 - Jesus' example of judging Phars: <u>Lk 11:42-45</u> hypocrisy; Lk 13:32; Mt 7:6, 15; 12:34; Jn 8:44. Also chides disciples Mt 16:23
- 4. We are to make ethical evaluations not superficial evaluations according to valuesystems that are not based on God's Word.
 - i. Put best construction on motives moral confusion [Isa 5:20].
 - ii. Judge in alignment w/ Father's common grace on men & His judgment of us in Jesus: today is the day of salvation.

- iii. A censorious spirit is prohibited <u>Mat 7:1-6</u>. Having removed log, see specks, dogs & pigs keeping your eyes on Jesus.
- 5. Conscience points to God as Judge and Judgment Day Rm 2:1-3; 3:9-10

Applic #1: Keep the Day of Judgment in View

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- 1. Ps 73 Asaph was misjudging things.
 - i. $\underline{v17}$ Asaph realigns w/ eternal perspective & perceived their end
 - ii. $\underline{v23-25}$ never forget grace
- 2. What is *their end?* Separation from Christ eternal death.

Applic #2: Remember, We are Not the Judge - Christ Is.

- 1. <u>Rm 14:4, 10-13</u> there is one Judge & one judgment seat God's.
- 2. <u>Jms 4:11-12</u> we are doers, not judges; we discern, not judge.
- 3. We must not preempt Jesus as Judge. Don't pluck up tares Mt 13:30.

Applic #3: We Must Repent Of and Be Warned Against a Censorious Spirit

- 1. Jude 1:16 those who will be exposed & judged at 2^{nd} coming
 - i. grumblers finding fault proud, manipulative, selfish
- 2. Why are we liable to be so critical? $\underline{v17}$ we forget Father's grace in Jesus.
- 3. We are authorized to administer God's gov't of grace fully aware that Jesus is the Judge of mankind. We call men to reconciliation & peace w/ God.
