# FILLING UP CHRIST'S AFFLICTIONS

#### Colossians 1:24–2:5

**ESV** 

[24] Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I am filling up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions for the sake of his body, that is, the church, [25] of which I became a minister according to the stewardship from God that was given to me for you, to make the word of God fully known, [26] the mystery hidden for ages and generations but now revealed to his saints. [27] To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory. [28] Him we proclaim, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all wisdom, that we may present everyone mature in Christ. [29] For this I toil, struggling with all his energy that he powerfully works within me.

[1] For I want you to know how great a struggle I have for you and for those at Laodicea and for all who have not seen me face to face, [2] that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit together in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ, [3] in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. [4] I say this in order that no one may delude you with plausible arguments. [5] For though I am absent in body, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good order and the firmness of your faith in Christ.

MAIN POINT: Christian ministry is not easy, but it's worth it.

### **1) SUFFERING** (1:24-27)

- Colossians 2:13—And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses...
- Titus 2:14 [Christ] gave himself for us to redeem us from <u>all</u> lawlessness

Salvation was <u>promised</u> from eternity past by the Father, <u>accomplished</u> by the Son on the cross, and it's being <u>applied</u> to the believers today through the regeneration of the Holy Spirit.

Mystery = A truth once concealed that is now revealed.

- **Genesis 12:3** God tells Abram, "I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."
- **Galatians 3:29**—And if you are <u>Christ's</u>, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise.

**2 Timothy 3:12**—Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted...

### **2) PROCLAMATION** (1:28-29)

- Christian preaching is <u>Christ</u>-centered.
- Christian preaching is a <u>balanced</u>.
- Christian preaching is goal oriented.

"God demands of us more than we can give, but he supplies us with more than we need."

**Colossians 3:13—**...<u>bearing with one another</u> and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; <u>as the Lord has forgiven you</u>, so you also must forgive.

## 3) ENCOURAGEMENT (2:1-3)

Struggle = agonizomi

Encouragement is <u>necessary</u> for the Christian walk.

This encouragement comes in two parts:

1) UNITY

A church that works together for Christ remains together in Christ.

2) ASSURANCE

"For every look at yourself, take ten looks at Christ." - Robert M'Cheyne

#### **4) PROTECTION** (2:4-5)

The job of a minister is to <u>comfort</u> the sheep with his voice, and with the same voice confront the wolf!

Christian ministry is not easy, but Christian ministry is worth it because the gospel is worth it!
