#### KEY TERMS

Personal Evangelism: *Private Christians bringing the gospel to lost sinners.*

Evangelistic Outreach: *Private Christians bringing the gospel to lost sinners with whom they have no pre-existing or ongoing relationship.*

Evangelistic Witness: *Private Christians bringing the gospel to lost sinners with whom they have an existing or ongoing relationship.*
