### The Blood of the Lamb (Exodus 11-12)

---

#### A typology

- The Lamb represents Jesus Christ
- Israel represents the chosen people of God
- The Exodus represents the process of salvation
- See Gen. 3:21, 4:4, 22:1-18; Isaiah 53:7-8 and Acts 8:32-33; John 1:29, 36; Luke 22:7; 1 Cor. 5:7-8; 1 Pet. 1:19; Rev. 7:14, 12:11.

#### The Nature of This Salvation

- We are saved by God from His wrath, (Rom. 5:9, 6:23; Prov. 11:4.)
- By His grace, (Eph. 2:8; 2 Tim. 1:9; Rom. 3:24.)
- Through our faith, as (John 3:14-18; Rom. 3:22-27; 1 Pet. 1:5.)
- Evidenced by our works. (James 2:14-26; Eph. 2:8-10; 2 Cor. 5:15.)

### The Memorial Feast

- The Lamb
- Unleavened bread
- Bitter herbs
- Belt, sandals, staff
- Jesus declares the bread as his body
- 1 Cor. 11:24, Luke 22:19.
- Jesus declares the wine as his blood
- 1 Cor. 11:25, Luke 22:20.
- See also Hebrews 9:11-14.

#### Some applications:

Am I certain that the blood of Jesus Christ will protect me from the wrath to come? What evidence do I have in my life?

How can I become better prepared to tell others about the coming judgment and their need for redemption in Jesus Christ?

What other Old Testament accounts might be considered part of the "Scarlet Thread" of scripture?
