From a \_\_\_\_\_, Nahum can look like an unfair book from a prophet who's bitter and angry at the oppression from Assyria.

From \_\_\_\_\_ we see an awesome view of a sovereign, just God.

God will judge his enemies,

**1:1-8—Psalm of God's Character**

**1:9-14—God Promises Peace**

**2—Nineveh is Attacked**

**3—Nineveh is Destroyed**

**Application:** Nahum is a warning to God's enemies, a warning that should lead us to pray for our country.

**3 ways we see hope in Nahum:**

1. By remembering who Nahum \_\_\_\_\_.
2. By remembering that the Lord \_\_\_\_\_ (1:7).
3. By looking to Jesus for hope and \_\_\_\_\_ (1:15).
