Introduction:

Main Point: "Moses was very humble, more than any man who was on the face of the earth" (Num. 12:3) and through his humility and faith the Lord used him to deliver Israel out of the bondage of Egypt and to lead them to the edge of the promised land. But Moses was not able to enter in. Why not? It was because that in his pride he did not sanctify the Lord God (Num. 20:6-13, 27:14; Psalm 106:32-33) and struck the Rock instead of speaking to it as commanded. This should cause us to pause and consider our own hearts and lives as we walk in the presence of the holy Lord and to look to Christ as the only one who perfectly obeyed the Father's will.
