

Genesis 1:26-31, 2:1-6

- 26 ¶ And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. *Don't hurry over this verse. The word 'God' here is a word that means plural entities. The Islamic nation says we worship many gods. Don't believe that. There is one God, 3 persons - the Trinity: God, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Spirit. Of all the creatures God has created: Lucifer, the angels, animal, plants; etc, only man has been created in His image. If there is other life out there in space that God put out there: #1: it is not in God's image, and #2; they don't need a savior or they are not our savior. Here He hasn't created Adam, Eve, or any children yet. But He told Moses to write it as it has already happened. When He does create Man, He wants man to have dominion over the earth.*
- 27 So God created man in his image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. *God made the male, God made the female, and that's the way it should be. No same-sex issues should exist.*
- 28 And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth. *Man will have dominion and rule over every living thing on earth. We can kill animals and eat them if we want. But we can also go to Kroger and get food if we want. If it comes down to a choice of man or the animals, it's going to be man winning.*
- 29 ¶ And God said, Behold, I have given you every herb bearing seed, which is upon the face of all the earth, and every tree, in the which is the fruit of a tree yielding seed; to you it shall be for food. *Man and all the animals were vegetarians at this point. Carnivores came to being after the great flood. In this day and age, if it moves, you are allowed to eat it. You can be a vegetarian if that's what you want, but it is not bible-dictated. Cults encourage vegetarianism. Eating meat deters demonic influence and demonic possession. The occultists are vegetarians for this very reason.*
- 30 And to every beast of the earth, and to every fowl of the air, and to every thing that creep upon the earth, wherein there is life, I have given every green herb for meat: and it was so. *God has provided all we need in the vegetable world for man and animals to survive just fine.*
- 31 ¶ And God saw every thing that he had made, and, behold, it was very good. And the evening and the morning were the sixth day. *Notice God says it was "very" good this time, not just plain good. Notice man was created on the 6th day. From God's standpoint, '666' means 'man, man, man.' The number '7' means 'complete,' the number '6' means 'man.'*

Chapter 2:1-6

- 1 ¶ Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. *This word 'finish' in Hebrew means 'complete', 'all set in order, for now and into the future.'*
- 2 And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.
- 3 And God blessed the seventh day, and sanctified it: because that in it he had rested from all his work which God created and made. *'Sanctified' means 'set aside'. This does not mean that God got tired. This is a principle. God set aside one day in seven to cease your normal activity, to set aside work, to change course, to do something other than what you do the other six days of the week. This is not a law, but rather a principle. After the French revolution, they decided to change the seven-day week to a ten-day week. Things got so messed up that every little thing that the French government finally had to go back to the seven day week. God had set it up that way from the beginning and it will not work if we change it. The seventh day is like a day to recharge your batteries. What day of the week is the Sabbath? The actual day is Friday sundown to Saturday sundown. It was given to Israel,*

but not the church. If you did anything Friday to Saturday sundown, you broke the law. You had to stay in bed and not move. Here in America, they used to shut down everything on Sundays. Absolutely nothing was open. If you needed groceries or gas, you had to get it on Saturday or wait until Monday.

- 4 ¶ *These are the generations of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens, ‘Generations’ means “families” in Hebrew. God took all His creation and grouped it into families: man families, horse families, cat families.*
- 5 *And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the LORD God had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and there was not a man to till the ground. Before Adam was ever put here, God was causing food to grow so man could survive. It didn’t rain on the earth until the times of Noah.*
- 6 *But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground. The earth was watered by a mist from the ground, not be rain from the sky.*
