Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and **ask for the <u>old</u> paths,** where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.

2. Gnostic:

"Gr. to know...The Gnostics were a sect of philosophers that arose in the first ages of christianity...They formed for themselves a system of theology, **agreeable to the philosophy of Pythagoras and Plato**, to which they **accommodated** their interpretations of scripture...These doctrines were derived from the **oriental philosophy**." (*Webster's*, 1828)

"Gnosticism represents a fusion of the intellectual and religious systems of the East and West, in which, however, the Eastern...predominated...Gnosticism...embodied...Egyptian, Phoenician...Buddhist...Alexandrian, Platonic...Cabbalistic lore...derived originally from Babylon...The Ophites first adopted the name Gnostic, their notions involving every shade of allegory, and mysticism...In times of persecution, Gnostics held that it was not required of them to suffer martyrdom rather than sacrifice at the altars of Paganism...no act of impiety could disqualify them from their inheritance. And this had a fatal influence on the church..."

"Gnosticism is the teaching based on...the knowledge of transcendence arrived at by way of interior, intuitive means...the world is flawed because it was created in a flawed manner...[fundamental Christians] interpret the Genesis myth as declaring that transgressions committed by the first human pair brought about a 'fall' of creation resulting in the present corrupt state of the world. Gnostics respond that this interpretation of the myth is false. The blame for the world's failings lies not with humans, but with the creator...In the Gnostic view, there is a true, ultimate and transcendent God, who is beyond all created universes and who never created anything...In a certain sense, it may therefore be true to say that **all is God**...[The creator in Genesis is] a being who became the creator of the material and psychic cosmos, all of which he created in the image of his own flaw. This being, unaware of his origins, imagined himself to be the ultimate and absolute God...Humans are generally ignorant of the divine spark resident within them...This ignorance is fostered in human nature by the influence of the false creator... [who is] intent upon keeping men and women ignorant of their true nature and destiny...In the course of history, humans progress...evolution of consciousness was envisioned by the Gnostics, long before the concept of evolution was known...Evolutionary forces alone are insufficient, however, to bring about spiritual freedom...To be liberated from this predicament, human beings require help...From earliest times Messengers of the Light have come forth from the True God in order to assist humans in their quest for Gnosis...Morality therefore needs to be viewed primarily in temporal and secular terms; it is ever subject to changes...Valentinus [was] the greatest of Gnostic teachers...[Carl] Jung was instrumental in calling attention to the Nag Hammadi library of Gnostic writings in the 1950's..."

Gnosticism, Panton wrote, had surfaced in the twentieth century in the forms of Theosophy, Christian Science, some forms of spiritualism, and in what was called the 'New Theology,' which had been introduced primarily by German writers on religion...While earlier crypto-Gnostics, such as Emanuel Swedenborg, William Blake, George Fox, and Elias Hicks camouflaged their heretical beliefs, Panton argued, twentieth-century Gnostics no longer bothered with concealment. The gnosticizing movements of the early twentieth century, wrote Panton, were 'frankly and jubilantly Gnostic'; their thought and their movements carried within them the 'throbbing heart of Gnosticism, perhaps the most dreaded foe the Christian faith ever confronted'...Panton still possessed a clear understanding of what constitutes Gnosticism. Such is not the case today...For man, the universe is a vast prison. He is enslaved both by the physical laws of nature and by such moral laws as the Mosaic code...Since the effort is to restore the wholeness and unity of the Godhead, active rebellion against the moral law of the Old Testament is enjoined upon every man..."
