TEXT: Jude 1:20-21

TITLE: "Keep on Loving God!"

→ Jude gives a powerful command for the saints to keep loving God and three ways to fulfill it.

As a church, we rejoice in the goodness of God for 133 years! What should we think today about the future? How can we maintain a Gospel witness for our children and grandchildren or until Jesus returns?

I believe the words of Jude from about 1,950 years ago are very fitting!—they answer that question.

- 1. Believers must apply their hearts to love God actively.
- 2. Believers need to exercise themselves in attitudes and actions that show their love for God.
- 3. In thought, word and deed, we are to maintain love for God!
- 4. Jehovah, Yahweh, commanded this to Israel.
 - → Deuteronomy 6:5; 10:12-13
- 5. Jesus also commanded this also!
 - → Matthew 22:37,
 - → Mark 12:30
 - → Luke 10:27
- B. We Must Be Aware of Our Tendency to Grow C_____
- 1. Our love for God can tend to grow cold and indifferent.
- 2. We can let all that goes on around us dull that love.

- 3. The church at Ephesus in Revelation 2:4—they had lost their first love.
 - → Revelation 2:4
- 4. Jude exhorts us to NOT do that.
- C. We Must Encourage Each Other to Fervent Love for Christ!
- 1. In the Greek text, "yourselves" is plural.
- 2. He is speaking to the whole body of believers, not just to individuals!
 - → So, how can we uphold our love for Jesus?

- 4. Jude Encourages Us to Build Ourselves up ON the FAITH!
