 - That Edgar Page Stites Wrote:
 - O Beulah Land, sweet Beulah Land,

As on thy highest mount I stand,

I look away across the sea,

Where mansions are prepared for me,

And view the shining glory shore,

My Heav'n, my home forevermore!

 - We See That For The Author:
 - Beulah Land Was *Not* Heaven!
 - Rather It Was Across The Sea From Heaven:
 - And It Was A Place Where He Could Look Over To Heaven!
 - And In Many Ways:
 - It Was A Taste Of Heaven:
 - While Still On Earth!
 - I Believe That Either Before Or While:
 - Edgar Stites Penned These Words:
 - He Must Have Been Meditating On The Passage We Come To Next:
 - In The Pilgrims Progress:
 - Which According To Many:
 - Is One Of The Most Beautiful & Descriptive Passages:
 - Bunyan Ever Wrote!
 - So Let's Look Together At:
 - What This Beulah Land Meant:
 - To Both The Hymn Writer & The Story Writer:
 - As We Turn Back To:
 - Page 97, Where We Will Start Reading At The Last Paragraph:
 - "Now I Saw In My Dream, That By This Time The Pilgrims Were Got Over The Enchanted Ground!"
 - Read Through: Page 99, Paragraph 1:
 - "So I Saw In My Dream That They Went On Together, Until They Came In Sight Of The Gate!"

 - There Are Two Main Passages:
 - That John Bunyan Used:
 - To Describe This Place:
 - He Called "The Country Of Beulah!"
 - First He Draws From Isaiah 62:
 - Which Is A Description Of:
 - The Future Home Of God's People:

- Zion!
- Let's Read Through This Chapter:
 - Trying To Pick Up Some Of The References:
 - Bunyan Used In His Story!
- 62:4-12 "Thou shalt no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall thy land any more be termed Desolate: but thou shalt be called Hephzibah, and thy land Beulah: for the LORD delighteth in thee, and thy land shall be married. / For as a young man marrieth a virgin, so shall thy sons marry thee: and as the bridegroom rejoiceth over the bride, so shall thy God rejoice over thee. / I have set watchmen upon thy walls, O Jerusalem, which shall never hold their peace day nor night: ye that make mention of the LORD, keep not silence, / And give him no rest, till he establish, and till he make Jerusalem a praise in the earth. / The LORD hath sworn by his right hand, and by the arm of his strength, Surely I will no more give thy corn to be meat for thine enemies; and the sons of the stranger shall not drink thy wine, for the which thou hast laboured: / But they that have gathered it shall eat it, and praise the LORD; and they that have brought it together shall drink it in the courts of my holiness. / Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard for the people. / Behold, the LORD hath proclaimed unto the end of the world, Say ye to the daughter of Zion, Behold, thy salvation cometh; behold, his reward is with him, and his work before him. / And they shall call them, The holy people, The redeemed of the LORD: and thou shalt be called, Sought out, A city not forsaken!"

 - And It Means "Married!"
 - Which Describes The Relationship That God Himself Will Have With His People:
 - Forever!
- The Second Passage Bunyan Draws From Is Song Of Solomon 2:
 - Which Describes The Tenderness:
 - Of Pure, Marital Love!
 - And In 2:10-12 It Is Pictured As:
 - Springtime In The Heart! "My beloved spake, and said unto me, Rise up, my love, my fair one, and come away. / For, lo, the winter is past, the rain is over and gone; / The flowers appear on the earth; the time of the singing of birds is come, and the voice of the turtle is heard in our land!"
- 4. Whatever & Wherever This Beulah Land Is:
 - It Sounds Exquisitely Beautiful & Restful!
 - And Yet From Bunyan's Perspective:
 - Its Not Quite Heaven!
 - So Just What Is This Place?
 - It's A Place Exclusively For Christians:
 - Who Are Ready For:
 - Such An Experience!
 - And You Can Only Know What It Is:
 - When You Experience It For Yourself!
 - George Cheever Describes It This Way:
 - Beulah Land Is:
 - An "Advanced Stage" Of Our Pilgrimage And:
 - Is "A Very Near, Deep, Blissful Communion With God!"
 - He Also Calls It:
 - "Heaven In The Soul!"
 - Perhaps We Can Call It:
 - A Glimpse Of Glory:
 - From An Earthy Suburb:
 - Of The Heavenly City!
 - And It Was An Experience:
 - That Seems To Have Been Often Talked About:
 - In Puritan Circles:
 - As They Were Preparing Themselves:
 - To Cross Over The River Of Death!
 - And As Such It Is:

A Place Of Looking! 1. - Of Looking With: - Clear Spiritual Vision: - At The Things Of The Lord! - Much Of What Christian & Hopeful Experienced: - Was A Feast For Their Eyes! - They Saw: - Flowers: - That Appeared Every Day! - They Saw: - The Sun: - Shining Both Night And Day! - They Saw: - The City: - Made Up Of: - Pearls & Precious Stones & Gold! - And Even Though They Experienced: - For Most Of Their Pilgrimage: - What We Are Told In: - 1 Corinthians 13:12 - "For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known!" - Yet - At This Stage: - Of Their Christian Journey: - The Glass Isn't As Dark: - As It Once Was! - But - How Can This Be? - Because They Are Seeing Things: - Not With Their: - Eyes Flesh! - But With Their: - Eyes Of Faith! - And The Stronger & Deeper Your Faith: - The More You Will See: - Of Your Heavenly Home: - Even Though You May Still Be: - On This Side Of The River Of Death! - But - Not Only Is It: - A Place Of Looking! - It Is Also: A Place Of Listening! 2. - All Of Their Senses Were Stimulated: - In This Beautiful Country Of Beulah! - They Heard: - Continual Sing Of Birds: - Including The Peaceful Coo: - Of The Turtle Dove! - They Heard: - Voices Of Encouragement: - As We Read From Isaiah: - "Thy Salvation Cometh!" - Can There Be Any Greater Sound: - To A Weary Christian Pilgrim: - Who Is Almost To The End: - Of Their Journey? - Of Course - In Bunyan's Story: - The Sounds Christian & Hopeful Hear: - Are Spiritual Sounds!

 - The Valley Of The Shadow Of Death!
 - They Also:
 - Have No More Reason To Fear:
 - Giant Despair:
 - Because They Can't Even See:
 - Doubting Castle Anymore!
 - I Don't Think John Bunyan:
 - Is Talking About:
 - Sinless Perfection:
 - After The Later Wesleyan-Holiness Tradition!
- But I Do Think He Believes:
 - That As Many Christians:
 - Draw Closer & Closer:
 - To Their Home-Going:
 - God Gives Them Dying Grace:
 - So That Their Greatest Fears May Be Overcome By Their Faith:
 - In The Lord!

- In Philippians 1:23:
 - Paul Wrote:
 - "For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better!"
- Paul Could Honestly Say This:
 - Because God Had Convinced Him Of:
 - No Guilt In Life, No Fear In Death!

- Remember How Christian & Hopeful Responded: - To All Of This Overwhelming Beauty & Grace? - They "Fell Sick" - Bunyan Tells Us! - "With Desire!" - Desire For What? - For The Full Experience: - Of Heaven Itself! - If A Christian Can: - Get A "Taste" Of It On Earth: - Imagine What: - The Full Meal: - Will Be Like! And: - If A Christian Can: - Get A "Glimpse" Of It On Earth: - Imagine What: - The Full Glory: - Will Be Like! - As We Read In 1 Corinthians 2:9-10: - Though - "Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him!" - Yet - "God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit!" - All Throughout His Writings: - The Apostle Paul:
 - Had His Sights On Heaven!
 - Perhaps There Were Many Times:
 - When He Had This Kind Of "Beulah Land" Experience!
 - Only To Be Restored To Service In This Life!
 - But He Still Longed For Heaven!
 - And With Every Passing Day:
 - He Could Sense Heaven:
 - Drawing Closer To Him!
