II. The Trial before Herod -- Luke 23:4-17

Isa 53:7 -- He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth.

Luke 13:31-33 -- Get out and depart from here, for Herod wants to kill You." ³² And He said to them, "Go, tell that fox,

B. A Mockery of a Trial

Isa. 53:2-3 -- He has no form or comeliness – He is despised and rejected by men.

v. 11 – treated him with contempt.

Literally -- counted him as nothing or worthless.

Deut.~17:8,9-If a matter arises which is too hard for you to judge, between degrees of guilt for bloodshed, between one judgment or another, or between one punishment or another, matters of controversy within your gates, then you shall arise and go up to the place which the LORD your God chooses.

Acts 4:27-28 -- For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together ²⁸ to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose determined before to be done.
