




















































































Series: Colossians

Sermon: Colossians 4:7-18

1. Paul was as an apostle, evangelist, teacher, church starter, missionary, and more. We often think of Paul being flying solo, a lone wolf, but if we pay attention to his letters, he is extremely thankful for the role that others play. What are some roles of the believers mentioned in Col. 4:7-18.

2. Paul ministered to and with many people. Like in Colossians 4, in Romans 16, Paul lists many people that he knows and cares for. How many people are mentioned by name in his closing comments in Romans 16:1-15? __ Did he only know their names, or did he seem to know the person? _____ In what ways do his words reflect Col. 4:6?

3. What are some lessons that could be learned from the life of Mark? Compare Acts 15:36-40 and the 2 Timothy 4:11 which was written years later. What might these two passages reveal about the character of Paul?

4. Read about Epaphras in Col. 1:7 and 4:12. What could be said about Epaphras based upon these two passages.

In what ways is he someone to exemplify?

5. Demas was serving with Paul for quite some time but ended up going back to the world (2 Tim. 4:9-10). What does James say about the love of the world.

B. What reason does John give as to why people had left Christianity in his day? See 2:19.

Have you known professing Christians, who like Demas, left you and left the faith? ____ How do you deal with such a person?

6. Read John 17:15-18. How are Christians to be in the world but not of the world? What is the difference?
