<sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day, to keep it holy. <sup>9</sup> Six days shalt thou labour, and do all thy work: <sup>10</sup> But the seventh day *is* the sabbath of the LORD thy God: *in it* thou shalt not do any work, thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter, thy manservant, nor thy maidservant, nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger that *is* within thy gates: <sup>11</sup> For *in* six days the LORD made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that in them *is*, and rested the seventh day: wherefore the LORD blessed the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

<sup>12</sup> Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

<sup>13</sup> Thou shalt not kill.

<sup>14</sup> Thou shalt not commit adultery.

<sup>15</sup> Thou shalt not steal.

<sup>16</sup> Thou shalt not bear false witness against thy neighbour.

<sup>17</sup> Thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's house, thou shalt not covet thy neighbour's wife, nor his manservant, nor his maidservant, nor his ox, nor his ass, nor any thing that *is* thy neighbour's.

## QUESTION # 119: WHAT ARE THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT?

### ANSWER:

THE SINS FORBIDDEN IN THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT ARE, ALL OMISSIONS OF THE DUTIES REQUIRED,<sup>A</sup> ALL CARELESS, NEGLIGENT, AND UNPROFITABLE PERFORMING OF THEM, AND BEING WEARY OF THEM;<sup>B</sup> ALL PROFANING THE DAY BY IDLENESS, AND DOING THAT WHICH IS IN ITSELF SINFUL;<sup>C</sup> AND BY ALL NEEDLESS WORKS, WORDS, AND THOUGHTS, ABOUT OUR WORLDLY EMPLOYMENTS AND RECREATIONS.<sup>D</sup>
