- 1. John preached in a **precise context** v.1-6
 - a. Note the **politicians** v.1
 - b. Note the **Priests** v.2
 - c. Note the particular **location** v.3
 - d. Note the theological **content** v.3
 - e. Note the prophetic **fulfillment** v.4-6
- 2. John preached about **personal** repentance v.7-19
 - a. Do you **reflect** on your personal sin? Repentance requires it. V.4-5
 - b. Do you **recognize** divine wrath? Repentance requires it. V.7
 - c. Do you **reject** ritualistic religion? Repentance requires it!
 - d. Is <u>real spiritual</u> conversion apparent in your life? Repentance demands it. V.9-14.
 - e. Do you **rely** on your spiritual heritage? Repentance requires individual treatment. V.8b
 - f. Do you **receive** the Savior? Repentance requires it. V.15-17.
- 3. John preached repentance in spite of **personal peril** v.18-20
 - a. This was not a **onetime message**
 - b. This is the message that cost him **his head**.

Have you truly **repented and turned** to Christ Jesus?
