

THE MAIN POINT OF ZEPHANIAH

What the Lord did to overthrow Judah is a preview of what he will do to the entire world for its rebellion.

Those who humbly repent will be shielded from God's wrath and experience celebration after sadness.

- 2. To be shielded from the coming judgment, you must humbly repent and draw near to God (Zephaniah 1:7; 2:3; 3:2; 3:15).

HOW CAN I BE SHIELDED FROM JUDGMENT?

God's wrath can only be exhausted by an offering. Justice will be satisfied either by the punishment of sinners or by the punishment of a substitute.

If you want to avoid judgment and draw near to God you must humble yourself, admit your waywardness, and trust that God gave Jesus to be punished as your Substitute.

- 1. You must realize that judgment is coming on earth (Zephaniah 1:2).
- 2. To be shielded from the coming judgment, you must humbly repent and draw near to God (Zephaniah 1:7; 2:3; 3:2; 3:15).
- 3. If you've drawn near to God through Jesus, you must anticipate the musical celebration (Zephaniah 3:15–17).
