## Ten Identifying Marks of God's Elect – 1 Thessalonians 1:1-10

- 1. 1:3a remembering your work of faith....
  - Identifying Mark #1 Work of Faith representing the transforming power of regeneration (Election) changing an individual's lifestyle.
- 2. 1:3b and labor of love....
  - Identifying Mark #2 <u>Labor of Love</u> represented by motivation to love <u>others</u>.

    Jesus said we "should love our neighbor as our self." The <u>Elect</u> has a compassion for serving others.
- 3. 1:3c and steadfastness of hope....
  - Identifying Mark #3 <u>Steadfastness of Hope</u> All true Believers have HOPE in Christ because only God's <u>Elect</u> can have confidence in God's promises.
- 4. 1:5 our gospel came to you <u>in power</u>....
  - Identifying Mark #4 The gospel came to them in power, not just by preaching of the Word, but the Word was driven by the power of the Holy Spirit.

    The Elect individual has the Holy Spirit's power living within him.
- 5. 1:6a you became <u>imitators</u> of us and of <u>the Lord...</u>
  - Identifying Mark #5 The <u>Elect</u> will live as much like (<u>imitate</u>) <u>Christ</u> as he/she can. (in their environment) Habits and lifestyles change when you imitate the Lord.
- 6. **1:6b** you received the word in much affliction and with Joy of the Holy Spirit... Identifying Mark #6 The Elect will have Joy in the Lord. No matter how tough the circumstances might be, a true Believer will never lose his Joy.
- 7. 1:7 so that you became an example to all believers....
  - Identifying Mark #7 One of the most effective ways of sharing Christ with the lost is to be an example (of Christ) in front of them. This is a trait of the God's Elect.
- 8. **1:8 not only has the word of the Lord sounded....<u>your faith has gone forth everywhere</u>
  Identifying Mark #8 <u>Faithfulness in proclaiming the gospel</u> verifies the mark of the Elect of God.**
- 9. **1:9** how you turn to God from idols....
  - Identifying Mark #9 Evidence of the Thessalonians' <u>Election</u> was <u>turning from idol</u>
    <u>worship</u>. When Christ is head of your life, there is no interest in other gods.
- 10. **1:10** to wait for His Son from heaven....
  - Identifying Mark #10 <u>anticipating the return of Christ</u> The <u>Elect</u> will long to see

    Christ. The longing to see Him is a clear evidence that God has chosen that Elect one.
