# Comprehensive Proclamation of God's Revealed Counsel

### Acts 20:27 (NASB)

For I did not shrink from declaring to you the whole purpose of God.

- The revealed purpose (*boule\_*) must be taught or the statement in vs 26 would not be true
- This includes God's plan of Messianic salvation for Jews and Gentiles
- This includes God's promises, future judgment, and the definition and ministries of the church

The Calling and Duties of Local Church Leaders <u>Acts 20:28 (NASB)</u> "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood. "Guard" is imperative in the Greek Overseers is *episkopos* Shepherd is the verb *poimaino\_* The Holy Spirit set overseers in the church

## Warning About External Wolves

#### Acts 20:29 (NASB)

I know that after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock;

- Paul continues with the shepherd imagery: they must guard against wolves
- Wolves pose a mortal threat to the church
- They have their own agenda and will bring false teaching which will pervert the gospel

and from among your own selves men will arise, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after them.

- Paul later wrote to Timothy in Ephesus (1 Tim. 1:3-7) about false teaching in the church
- The false teaching that will come will be legalistic in some cases and libertine in others: 1 Tim. 6:3-5; 2 Timothy 3:1-9).
- See 1 John 2:19; The earliest church fathers linked John to Ephesus in the late 1<sup>st</sup> century
