"BECOMING MAN" Part 1 JOHN 1:1-3,14; LUKE 1:26-38; SELECTED SUPPORT SCRIPTURES

HE IS GOD BEFORE HE BECOMES MAN John 1:1-3; I. Colossians 1: ; Psalm 8

- A. God creates earth and a human team to rule it
 - 1. He makes them in His own image
 - a. Person like Him in personality
 - b. Rule with authority and power but without the need to own; stewardship
 - c. Appearance likeness of the Christ
 - 2. He will rule through them by His own blessing
 - a. Authorized to reproduce themselves
 - b. Authorized to modify the earth to the likeness of the Garden of Eden to fill the earth with His glory

c. To secure ample provision for all the other creatures as God Himself would do; they are His image

3. This is modeled off what Jesus will be and do

- B. It is the second person of the Trinity through whom and for whom it is all being created. He is its maker, redeemer/restorer, inheritor and sovereign
- C. He is the Word that created it and the One whom holds it all together
- D. He is before all creation as He is God, eternal and uncreated
- E. This Word became flesh and tabernacled with us, unrecognized by His own

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- II. GOD BECOMES A MAN
 - *A. The Word became flesh* John 1:14; Luke 1:26-38; Galatians 4:4-5; Hebrews 10:5-7; John 3:16
 - B. ...the only begotten of the Father..."
 - 1. Of the same stuff as the one who begat Him
 - 2. The child of promise, not the flesh
 - 3. The inheritor of the promise of the Father
 - 4. This begetting took place BEFORE the world began and was revealed in TIME that God determined was the optimum
 - *C. "...born of a woman, born under the law..."* Genesis 3:15; Psalm 2; Hebrews 10:5-7; Luke 1:26-38
 - 1. God's amazing promise to Eve
 - 2. God's promise to His Son-Sovereign inheritance
 - 3. God's preparation of a body for the Son and the Son's promise to completely to the will of God
 - 4. God's power to bring His only begotten into the world by a natural gestation and delivery
 - a. The Holy Spirit's overshadowing brings cleansing, indwelling of the full Christ and conception of a full human
 - b. The is the full and complete union of the second person of the Trinity and a human being– He is fully God and fully human in one person
 - c. His divine "side" is in willing submission to the Father while His humanity will still have to mature, learn, trust and grow.
