

Loyalties (5)
1 Samuel 20:18–42

Rightly responding to the Lord's anointed.

David entrusted his life to the Lord, Jonathan entrusted his life to David.

Jonathan and David made a plan to discover God's will - v. 20:18–24

- David was filled with the Holy Spirit but he did not know everything.
- Jonathan filled in the details of the plan.
- If the threat was real then David must go.
- We must accept that it is God's will to suffer - **Hebrews 5:8; 2:9–11**

Jonathan carries out the plan to discover God's will - v. 20:25–29

- Saul was driven by hate and can't control his wickedness - **Proverbs 26:11 As a dog returns to his own vomit, So a fool repeats his folly; Proverbs 27:3 A stone is heavy and sand is weighty, But a fool's wrath is heavier than both of them.**
- Saul knew that David was a godly man who followed God's law.
- When questioned by Saul, Jonathan answered with a ruse. There was the actual lie and injustice that needed to be revealed - **Exodus 23:6–7**
- Jonathan inserted himself between Saul and David by making himself culpable for David's absence.

Jonathan discovers the truth - v. 20:30–34

- Saul did want to murder David.
- Saul threw shame and guilt upon Jonathan for siding with David.
- Saul tried to tempt Jonathan to oppose David.
- Jonathan would not betray David.

Jonathan sends David away - v. 20:35–42

- Jonathan signals to David that he must flee.
- The young boy was part of the plan and didn't know it.
- Jonathan disarmed himself before David to show his loyalty.
- David bowed three times before Jonathan to show his subordination.
- Jonathan and David kissed and wept to show their mutual affection.
- David wept more because he began to feel the high cost of becoming king.
- Jonathan believed that David would have the final vindication and victory and so entrusted his life to him.
- Jonathan was by nature an enemy of David's but David made him his friend.

Do you believe that the greater Son of David will have the final vindication and victory?

Psalm 110:1 A Psalm of David. The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool."

We are by nature an enemy of Christ but Christ had made us his friend - **Romans 5:10**
