once saved always saved vs. perseverance of the saints
Our need for shaking

II. A great shaking (vs. 26-27)

Haggai 2:3-9: The good news about shaking Shaking results in stability Lord, shake us so that only that which is unshakeable remains!

III. The response of God's unshakeable people (vs. 28-29)

Encouragements follow warnings (3:7-19/4:1-11, 6:1-8/6:9-12, 10:26-31/10:32-39)
