Promise #1. God will save you

Romans 10:9-13

*“...if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, **you will be saved.**”*

***10** For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made **unto salvation.** **11** For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.” **12** For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. **13** For “whoever calls on the name of the Lord **shall be saved.**”*

3 parts of this promise

- ◆ Confess
- ◆ Believe
- ◆ Salvation

Confess (v9)

if you **confess...**

...with your **mouth...**

...the **Lord Jesus**

Believe (v9)

...and **believe**

...in your **heart**...

...that God has **raised**
him from the dead

...you will be **saved**.

7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die; yet perhaps for a good man someone would even dare to die. 8 But **God demonstrates His own love** toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be **saved from wrath** through Him. 10 For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.
