ł.	What It Is - true thanksgiving is a life of praise in response to abundant, generous grace of God. A. The figure of sacrifice teaches that thanksgiving is a response to God's grace.
	B. Thanksgiving is a response of praise.
	C. Thanksgiving is an attitude by which we live our lives - continually.
11.	 How It Is Offered A. The thanksgiving sacrifice is not an animal or a loaf of bread; it is not what we have grown in our gardens, but the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name.
	B. Thanksgiving is not simply offered at certain times of worship, but it is a life of worship.
111.	How This Is Possible - by Him. A. It is only through Jesus Christ that we can offer this sacrifice of thanksgiving.
