The "Good" Shepherd!! As the "Good" Shepherd,....

Jesus Christ gives His life for His sheep! 10:11-13, 17-18

- Background
 - Shepherding was a hard, dangerous job
 - To care for his flock, a shepherd would hire others to help
 - Not responsible for loss—Exodus 22:12-13
 - Did it for the pay
 - Contrast between "thieves, robbers, and hired men"
- In contrast to the hireling, Jesus Christ lays down His life 2.
 - As a substitutionary Sacrifice—10:11-13
 - Scriptural testimony—Christ died for us Prophesied in the OT—Isaiah 53:4-6
 - Voluntarily, out of love and obedience 10:17-18
 - Jesus' death not an accident or tragedy, but part of God's plan from eternity to provide salvation for you and I.
 - Jesus' death not a suicide, but a sacrifice—John 15:13
 - Jesus' death was the means of life to those who believe

Jesus Christ sustains a love relationship with His sheep! 10:14-15

- Jesus Christ "knows" His sheep!
- We "know" Jesus Christ, proven by our obedience to Him
- The relationship which we have with Christ is intertwined with the relationship Jesus Christ 3. has with His Father.
- God the Father loves you; Jesus Christ loves you; and You love the Father and Jesus Christ! He loves us; We obey Him!

Jesus Christ unites His sheep into one flock—10:16

- One flock-One Shepherd in the Old Testament
 - Most thought it referred to gathering scattered Israel
 - Hints that "flock" may include Gentiles—Isaiah 56:6-8
- One flock—One Shepherd revealed in the New
 - Salvation is for both Jew and Gentile—Romans 1:16
 - b. "Mystery of Christ"—Gentiles included—Ephesians 3:5-6
 - Jesus makes the "two", one—a new flock Ephesians 2:11-16
