#### SUMMARY STATEMENT

Ezekiel calls us to remember we are <u>exiles</u> and as <u>exiles</u> to remember that God is <u>near</u> and is infinitely concerned for His own <u>glory</u>.

Therefore Ezekiel calls us to refuse the <u>temptation</u> to place our <u>hope</u> in an imagined <u>past</u> or an alluring <u>present</u> but instead to <u>repent</u> and to <u>wait</u> for God's future <u>salvation</u>.

# WHAT IS THE NATURE OF GOD'S WORD?

God's Word is <u>hard</u> but <u>good</u>, <u>deadly</u> but <u>life</u>-giving, and should be <u>handled</u> with <u>reverence</u>.

# WHAT IS THE NATURE OF GOD'S MESSENGER?

He is <u>empowered</u> by God's <u>Spirit</u>, <u>filled</u> with God's <u>Word</u>, and ready to <u>suffer</u> for God's <u>message</u>.

God commands Ezekiel to be His Messenger

#### GOD'S MESSENGER MUST SPEAK GOD'S MESSAGE:

l. Clearly (truthfully) – even to those who won't listen

#### **EZEKIEL 2:3-5**

<sup>3</sup> And he said to me, "Son of man, I send you to the people of Israel, to nations of rebels, who have rebelled against me. They and their fathers have transgressed against me to this very day.4 The descendants also are impudent and stubborn: I send you to them, and you shall say to them, Thus says the Lord GOD. And whether they hear or refuse to hear (for they are a rebellious house) they will know that a prophet has been among them.

Ezekiel was sent to speak God's message clearly even if they won't listen

#### EZEKIEL 3:4

<sup>4</sup> And he said to me, "Son of man, go to the house of Israel and speak with my words to them.

Ezekiel was sent to speak God's message clearly (exactly)

Ezekiel was to declare exactly and clearly what God had said

#### GOD'S MESSENGER MUST SPEAK GOD'S MESSAGE:

- 1. Clearly (truthfully) even to those who won't listen
- 2. <u>Boldly</u> even to those who reject

#### **EZEKIEL 2:6-7**

- <sup>6</sup> And you, son of man, be not afraid of them, nor be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns are with you and you sit on scorpions. Be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, for they are a rebellious house. And you shall speak my words to them, whether they hear or refuse to hear, for they are a rebellious house.
- Ezekiel was NOT to be afraid of those to which he was sent to speak
  He was to keep speaking God's message boldly even when rejected

#### **EZEKIEL 3:7-9**

<sup>7</sup> But the house of Israel will not be willing to listen to you, for they are not willing to listen to me: because all the house of Israel have a hard forehead and a stubborn heart. Behold, I have made your face as hard as their faces, and your forehead as hard as their foreheads. § Like emery harder than flint have I made your forehead. Fear them not, nor be dismayed at their looks, for they are a rebellious house."

#### **EZEKIEL 3:16-18**

<sup>16</sup> And at the end of seven days, the word of the LORD came to me: 17 "Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel Whenever you hear a word from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me. 18 11 say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die,' and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, in order to save his life, that wicked person shall die for his iniquity, but his blood I will require at your hand.

#### **EZEKIEL 33:4**

<sup>1</sup> The word of the LORD came to me:<sup>2</sup> "Son of man, speak to your people and say to them, If I bring the sword upon a land, and the people of the land take a man from among them, and make him their watchman and if he sees the sword coming upon the land and blows the trumpet and warns the people,4 then if anyone who hears the sound of the trumpet does not take warning, and the sword comes and takes him away, his blood shall be upon his own head.

#### **EZEKIEL 3:16-18**

<sup>16</sup> And at the end of seven days, the word of the LORD came to me: 17 "Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel Whenever you hear a word from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me. 18 11 say to the wicked, 'You shall surely die,' and you give him no warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, in order to save his life, that wicked person shall die for his iniquity, but his blood I will require at your hand.

#### **EZEKIEL 3:21**

But if you warn the righteous person not to sin and he does not sin, he shall surely live, because he took warning, and you will have delivered your soul."

Ezekiel was to speak God's message as a timely warning to those in need of warning

#### GOD'S MESSENGER MUST SPEAK GOD'S MESSAGE:

#### **EZEKIEL 3:24-27**

Ezekiel was to speak only God's message

<sup>24</sup> But the Spirit entered into me and set me on my feet, and he spoke with me and said to me, "Go, shut yourself within your house. 25 And you, O son of man, behold, cords will be placed upon you, and you shall be bound with them, so that you cannot go out among the people. 26 And I will make your tongue cling to the roof of your mouth, so that you shall be mute and unable to reprove them, for they are a rebellious house.<sup>27</sup> But when I speak with you, I will open your mouth, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD.' He who will hear, let him hear; and he who will refuse to hear, let him refuse, for they are a rebellious house.

<sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

#### HEBREWS 1:1-2 like Ezekiel

Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world.

#### JESUS AS GOD'S PERFECT MESSENGER:

- 1. Was God's <u>ultimate</u> <u>messenger</u>
- 2. Was filled with God's Spirit perfectly

#### LUKE 4:1, 14, 18

- <sup>1</sup> And Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the wilderness
- <sup>14</sup> And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit to Galilee, and a report about him went out through all the surrounding country.
- <sup>17</sup> And the scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where it was written, <sup>18</sup> "The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, <sup>19</sup> to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor."

<sup>39</sup> ... Jesus said to them, "If you were Abraham's children, you would be doing the works Abraham did, <sup>40</sup> but now you seek to kill me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. This is not what Abraham did.

<sup>28</sup> So Jesus said to them, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am he, and that I do nothing on my own authority, but speak just as the Father taught me.

#### JOHN 12:49-50

For I have not spoken on my own authority, but the Father who sent me has himself given me a commandment--- what to say and what to speak. <sup>50</sup> And I know that his commandment is eternal life. What I say, therefore, I say as the Father has told me."

# **JOHN 5:19**

<sup>19</sup> So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise.

### **LUKE 11:47-52**

<sup>47</sup>Woe to you! For you build the tombs of the prophets whom your fathers killed. 48 So you are witnesses and you consent to the deeds of your fathers, for they killed them, and you build their tombs.49 Therefore also the Wisdom of God said, 'I will send them prophets and apostles, some of whom they will kill and persecute, '50 so that the blood of all the prophets, shed from the foundation of the world, may be charged against this generation, 51 from the blood of Abel to the blood of Zechariah, who perished between the altar and the sanctuary. Yes, I tell you, it will be required of this generation.

# **LUKE 13:33-34**

33 Nevertheless, I must go on my way today and tomorrow and the day following, for it cannot be that a prophet should perish away from Jerusalem. 134 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often would I have gathered your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you would not!

#### **EZEKIEL 2:3-4**

<sup>3</sup> And he said to me, "Son of man, I send you to the people of Israel, to nations of rebels, who have rebelled against me. They and their fathers have transgressed against me to this very day. 4 The descendants also are impudent and stubborn: I send you to them, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD.'

# **EZEKIEL 3:27**

<sup>27</sup> But when I speak with you, I will open your mouth, and you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD.' He who will hear, let him hear; and he who will refuse to hear, let him refuse, for they are a rebellious house.

### **HEBREWS 3:7-11**

<sup>7</sup> Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "Today, if you hear his voice, 8 do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, on the day of testing in the wilderness, 9 where your fathers put me to the test and saw my works for forty years. <sup>10</sup> Therefore I was provoked with that generation, and said, 'They always go astray in their heart; they have not known my ways.' 11 As I swore in my wrath, 'They shall not enter my rest."

### **HEBREWS 3:12-15**

12 Take care, brothers, lest there be in any of you an evil, unbelieving heart, leading you to fall away from the living God. 13 But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin. 14 For we have come to share in Christ, if indeed we hold our original confidence firm to the end. 15 As it is said, "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."
