## **SUMMARY STATEMENT**

Ezekiel calls us to remember we are exiles and as exiles to remember that God is near and is infinitely concerned for His own glory.

Therefore Ezekiel calls us to refuse the temptation to place our hope in an imagined past or an alluring present but instead to repent and to wait for God's future salvation.



<sup>9</sup> then those of you who escape will remember me among the nations where they are carried captive, how I have been broken over their whoring heart that has departed from me and over their eyes that go whoring after their idols. And they will be loathsome in their own sight for the evils that they have committed, for all their abominations.



<sup>10</sup> And they shall know that I am the LORD. I have not said in vain that I would do this evil to them."

Do the pursuits of my life testify to the world that God is my greatest joy?

## **ROMANS 2:1-5**

**<sup>1</sup> Therefore you have no excuse, O man, every one of you who judges.**

**For in passing judgment on another you condemn yourself, because you, the judge, practice the very same things.<sup>2</sup> We know that the**

**judgment of God rightly falls on those who practice such things.<sup>3</sup> Do**

**you suppose, O man---you who judge those who practice such things and yet do them yourself---that you will escape the judgment of God?**

**<sup>4</sup> Or do you presume on the riches of his kindness and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to**

**repentance?<sup>5</sup> But because of your hard and impenitent heart you are**

**storing up wrath for yourself on the day of wrath when God's righteous**

**judgment will be revealed.**

## **I COR 10:14-22**

**<sup>14</sup> Therefore, my beloved, flee from idolatry. <sup>15</sup> I speak as to sensible people; judge for yourselves what I say. <sup>16</sup> The cup of blessing that we bless, is it not a participation in the blood of Christ? The bread that we break, is it not a participation in the body of Christ? <sup>17</sup> Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread.**

## **I COR 10:14-22**

**<sup>18</sup> Consider the people of Israel: are not those who eat the sacrifices participants in the altar? <sup>19</sup> What do I imply then? That food offered to idols is anything, or that an idol is anything? <sup>20</sup> No, I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons. <sup>21</sup> You cannot drink the cup of the Lord and the cup of demons. You cannot partake of the table of the Lord and the table of demons. <sup>22</sup> Shall we provoke the Lord to jealousy? Are we stronger than he?**

# **I JOHN 5:21**

**<sup>21</sup> Little children, keep yourselves from idols.**

Am I willing to forsake everything that distracts me from God's glory?  
Or, are there things in my life that aren't pursuing God's glory, but I love them too much to give them up?
